PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Parishioners:

This coming Wednesday, March 6, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the holy season of Lent. Lent is the 40-day season of penance and renewal before Easter. I want to invite you all to embrace the spirit of Lent at the beginning of the season and sustain it all throughout the duration of the holy season. The spirit of Lent is repentance. The spirit of Lent is self-denial. The spirit of Lent is fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. The spirit of Lent is sacrifice. During Lent, we repent of our sins, personal and corporate. On Ash Wednesday, we accept the sign of ashes on our foreheads to remind us that we are dust. We are sinners and we repent in sackcloth and ashes. We accept this humiliation as an antidote to our pride. We wish to make reparation for our own sins, the sins of others, the sins of the world and the sins of the Church. Masses on Ash Wednesday are 6:30 and 8:30 a.m., 12:15 and 7:00 p.m. Ashes are distributed during the Mass, and also during the Liturgy of the Word held at 4:45 p.m.

I want to make a few suggestions for a Holy Lent. In addition to the fasting and abstinence imposed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent, and in addition to the voluntary sacrifices you may make, as well as the practice of prayer and almsgiving you will fulfill, consider these possibilities:

- Participate in daily Mass on all the weekdays of Lent. Daily Mass takes place at 6:30 and 8:30 a.m., Monday through Friday, and 9:00 a.m. on Saturday.
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- Attend and pray the Stations of the Cross on Friday nights in Church at 7:30 p.m.
- Participate in our Parish Mission, March 10-13!
- Use the Lenten resources available for free on FORMED (standrewcolumbus.formed.org)

I wish you all a holy time of renewal this season of Lent!

Tuition Assistance Applications for St. Andrew School K-Grade 8 must be filed by March 15 for families to be considered for assistance. Only one application per family is required. Payment of \$35 must accompany the application. Additional documentation is required such as: 2018 W2, 2017 Federal Tax Return. Failure to provide required documentation will affect eligibility for assistance from both the Diocese and St. Andrew Parish.


