
PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Parishioners:

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. After Jesus' Resurrection from the dead, He appeared to His disciples over the course of forty days. Then He was taken up into heaven and appeared to them no more. Before His ascension, Jesus told His disciples to await the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Jesus told His disciples that "when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will receive power, and you will be my witnesses to the ends of the Earth" (cf. Acts 1:9).

The days between the Ascension and Pentecost are a special time to pray for the renewal of the gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Church. This was the original "Novena" of prayer. "Novena" comes from the Latin word novem, meaning nine, the number of days that fall between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost Sunday. Although, because Ascension is transferred to Sunday, there are fewer days; nevertheless, it is most fitting that we pray each day this week for the outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit upon the Church and on each one of us as members of the Church. Let us pray that we may be renewed and strengthened in our witness to Jesus our Savior. And, let us pray also for the outpouring of the Spirit's gifts upon St. Andrew Parish and all parishioners, that the Spirit may move them to use their gifts to build up our community of faith. "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your spirit, and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth."
