**PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear Parishioners:

This past Tuesday (July 9) was “moving day” in the Diocese of Columbus, the day when priests who are being reassigned move to their new assignments. Six years ago on this same date, July 9, 2013, I moved into my new assignment here at St. Andrew Parish. That was an exciting and joyous day for me as I began my pastorate with great anticipation and expectation, along with a little anxiety, due to the responsibilities I would be taking on. It is hard to believe that six years have flown by since then, but those years have been very happy and fulfilling for me.
