Dear Parishioners:

Right after school let out, work began on the lower corridor of the school. That work is progressing nicely and when school opens on August 21, a bright new corridor with new floors, surfaces, lighting and ceilings will be ready. This past week, work began on the replacement of the flat roofs of the gym and cafeteria/music room wing of the school. Earlier this summer, aging air conditioning units were replaced at the rectory. All the while, the summer maintenance crew has been busy with a variety of projects to keep everything clean, shining and working properly.

Things are also getting very busy with preparations for the Festival at St. Andrew coming on August 16/17. This event is sure to be the highlight of the summer season here at St. Andrew. 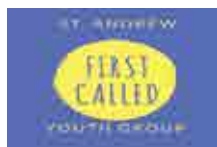
