A NOTE FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Whether we've taken the time to reflect much on it or not, each one of us has a life mission from God for the amount of time that we get to spend on this earth. Each one of us has a great calling from God, a vocation, that we are to live up to: the call to Holiness..." Be perfect as your Heavenly Father is Perfect " (Mt. 5:48). Sounds like a tall order! However, this type of "perfection" we call Holiness isn't something we do on our own, and it is never really too far away from us. Instead it is how we respond to God's graces and the opportunities He gives us every day of our lives, to be willing to trust Him, and put that greatest commandment, to Love God and Neighbor, into action. It is important for each of us to recognize the gifts and talents God has given us and, just as important, to take time to pray and discern how best to put them to use to serve God and others.

We hear Jesus say in today's Gospel passage, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." With this in mind, I would ask that you take time to pray intentionally for your fellow members of St. Andrew parish, young and old: that we may have to strength and courage to respond to our specific vocation from God. Pray, especially at this time, for young men from our parish to have the courage to respond to God's call to become priests. Without priests ordained to do what Jesus Christ does, there is no Eucharist, no sacramental confession. Priests don't just fall out of the sky, they come from families like yours!
