PASTOR'S CORNER

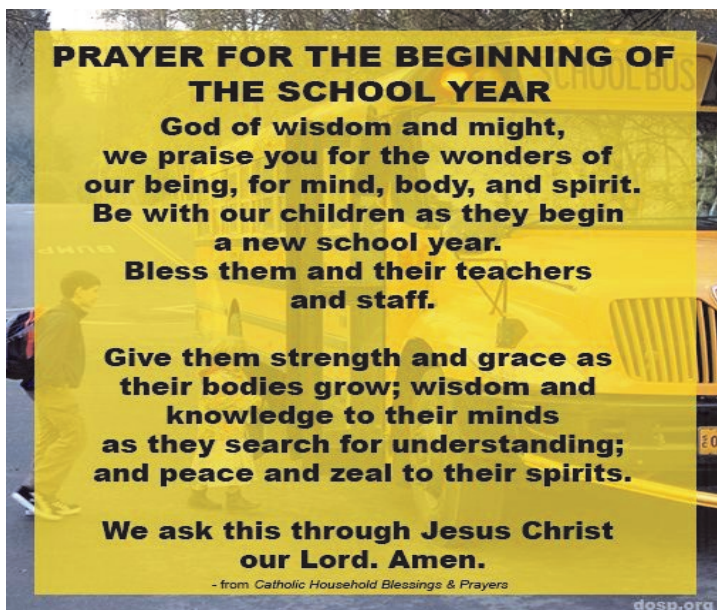
Dear Parishioners:
