PASTOR'S CORNER


Dear Parishioners,

A couple of weeks ago, I asked you parishioners to give me your thoughts, ideas and suggestions regarding a possible change to our Sunday Mass scheduler here at St. Andrew Parish. I want to thank all of you who gave me your feedback. In the last two weeks, I have heard from dozens of you. Many of you spoke to me after Masses, others left me phone messages with your opinions. I thank you very much for expressing your thoughts with me on this proposal. I would like to share with you the first impressions of what I have heard from you, a "preliminary report" if you will. I am still wishing to hear from more of you, so if you have something to say about this, please do so!

So far, based on what I have heard from you, there is a broad consensus in favor of changing the Sunday Mass schedule and reducing Sunday morning Masses from 4 to 3 in number. Not a single parishioner said "don't do it." (I did, however, hear from two non-parishioners who opposed any change!) I was surprised by the number of parishioners who were enthusiastic about the proposed change. Some expressed that they were excited about the change. Others told me it was long overdue. A number of parishioners expressed regret that Mass attendance has declined, but also recognized that this fact makes the reduction of Masses inevitable. There was also a broad consensus favoring the proposed Mass schedule: 7:30, 9:30 and 11:30. A number of parishioners were pleased with the proposed 9:30 Mass time, as it allows more time to prepare for Mass and "warm up." A number of comments expressed approval of spacing the Masses 2 hours apart, as this will alleviate parking lot congestion between Masses. I have received a few suggestions for different Mass times than those proposed. A few people suggested that the proposed 11:30 Mass would be better at 11:00 a.m., for example. Another suggestion was to consider a Sunday evening Mass.

As I said above, this is just a preliminary report. No decision on this proposal has been made as yet, and there is still time for you to weigh in on the subject! Thank you again for letting me know your opinions!





FIRST CALLED YOUTH GROUP NEWS








