PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent -- already! Although we speak of Advent as a time of waiting and patient watchfulness, I experience this season as a whirlwind and mad rush, which is over quickly, and Christmas is here before I am ready for it or prepared for it! I expect many of you experience the same. Perhaps this is God's way of reminding us that the day of the Lord's return is coming quickly, so we must get ready!

We usually refer to the return of the Lord, when He "comes again in glory to judge the living and the dead" as His "second coming." But did you know there is a third coming, also? St. Bernard in all of his seminars explains this. He said, at His first coming, the Lord was seen on earth, dwelling among men. This refers to His incarnation and earthly life, beginning with His birth in Bethlehem to His death on Calvary. At the "second coming," "all flesh will see the salvation of our God" as He comes again in glory and majesty. The third coming, says St. Bernard, is between the other two, and is invisible, for He comes to those who believe in Him within themselves. St. Bernard summarizes the "three comings of the Lord" this way: "In His first coming, our Lord came in the flesh; in the middle coming, He comes in spirit and power; in the final coming He comes in glory and majesty." It strikes me that these three "comings" of the Lord are expressed beautifully in the Penitential Rite at Mass which is often used in Advent.

"You came to gather the nations into the peace of God's Kingdom, Lord have mercy.

You come in word and sacrament to strengthen us in His holiness, Christ have mercy.

You will come again in glory with salvation for Your people, Lord have mercy."

I hope all of you will recognize and welcome the Lord who comes to you in word and sacrament in these fleeting days of Advent!

Monday of this week is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Please note that it is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation this year. The feast was transferred to December 9th because the Second Sunday of Advent takes precedence. When this occurs, the observance of the feast is transferred to the next day, but the obligation to attend Mass is not transferred.

As you read this, I am probably already in Rome. I am with Bishop Brennan and the other bishops of the Ohio-Michigan region as they make the "ad limina" visit to the Holy See. On Monday, December 9, the audience with Pope Francis is scheduled, and I hope to meet him in person on that occasion!

May you know that the Lord is near in these days of Advent!

Parishioners are asked to select an "ornament" or two from baskets near the trees at the entrances to the church and fulfill the wish.




