PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

Perhaps you missed reading my "Pastor's Corner" letter in this bulletin for the last two weekends (or maybe you didn't!). With the holidays falling mid-week and the early deadlines for the bulletins, I simply did not get anything written and submitted for the bulletin two weeks in a row! Now that the holidays are past and we are back on a normal schedule, I am back, also. I will try not to miss any more!

This weekend, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. This feast marks the end of the Christmas season, so I want to express my thanks to all who made all of our celebrations so beautiful during this season: especially our choir, cantors and musicians under the direction of Philip Lortz, those who decorated the church so beautifully, the Altar Servers, Lectors, Communion Ministers, Ushers and Greeters. I also want to thank all of you for your greetings and holiday wishes. As we enter the new year and new decade, I wish all of you health and happiness.

Once again, I want to thank all who have commented and made suggestions regarding the proposed new weekend Mass schedule. Some people have been asking me, "When will the new schedule begin?" This tells me that the time has come to announce definitively what the new Mass schedule will be and when it will take effect. So here it is!

The new weekend Mass schedule is as follows:

Saturday	4:30 p.m.
Sunday	7:30 a.m.
Sunday	9:15 a.m.
Sunday	11:00 a.m.

This new Mass schedule will take effect Sunday, April 19 (the Sunday after Easter).

This will give us plenty of time to prepare for this change. I anticipate that not everyone will be happy with this change, but we all have to make sacrifices at times. I believe that as Catholics, we have a grave obligation to attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation and, thus, other activities and commitments on Sunday must be considered secondary. Another challenge will be the rescheduling of some Mass Intentions that have already been requested for Sunday Masses after April 12. With only 3 Masses on Sundays, some intentions that have already been scheduled for the noon Mass will need to be rescheduled to another Mass time. I am sorry for this inconvenience, but we are counting on your understanding and flexibility. May God bless you all in this New Year!



CHRISTMAS DECOR REMOVAL HELP NEEDED






