## The Blessing of a Thankful Heart

In today's Gospel, the disciples questioned Jesus if sin caused the man's blindness. Did he or someone in his family warrant this punishment by their offense to God? The disciples listened and accepted Jesus' explanation that the man's lack of sight was not due to sin but instead was to show the glory of God. Meanwhile, the Pharisees refused to accept Jesus' teaching and in essence became the blind ones. Ironically, their inability to see could be directly attributed to sin — specifically, the sin of pride.

They refused to believe in the miracle which had occurred right before them and would never be able to see the miracles Jesus could perform in their lives. Their metaphorical blindness remained because they were unwilling to believe in any truth other than their own. Jesus has the power and authority to open anyone's eyes, to break through anyone's darkness, but first we have to be willing to see.

Sometimes we face circumstances truly beyond our control, which make

us wonder what we've done to be abandoned by God or what may have angered him. It is imperative to understand an important truth about God: He does not bring hardships; these exist as a result of the Fall in the Garden of Eden. God has given each of us free will so that we may be able to freely choose to enter into a relationship with him — one based on love, not coercion.

Trusting in God's promises that "all things work for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose" (Rom 8:28), or that "for human beings this is impossible, but for God all things are possible" (Mt

19:26), can be difficult in the midst of a tragedy, trial, or difficulty. However, one who continues to pray in thanksgiving maintains a grateful heart and remains hopeful, like the man born blind. Although Jesus' method of curing the man's blindness may have seemed strange, the man, thankful for a chance at healing, followed Jesus' instructions.

Lent is the perfect time to rub mud in our eyes, figuratively speaking, and allow Jesus to heal our spiritual blindness. Whether currently struggling through a difficult time, or scars from past battles that are hard to forget, prayers of thanksgiving can mold those experiences into blessings. Clarity of vision of the cumulative experiences in our lives belong only with God; apart from him, we will never make sense of them. Remaining close, thankful, and open to seeing his hand in all that happens in the world, keeps our hearts safeguarded from growing hard. Lent is a time to reflect on what blinds us from saying, "Lord, I believe," and a time to refocus on following the Light of the World.



## PRAYER TIP

When do you find time for prayer within a typically busy day? Some days do not lend themselves to dedicated or uninterrupted prayer time. Instead of skipping prayer, find ways to build it into the things you are already doing. Here are a few suggestions:

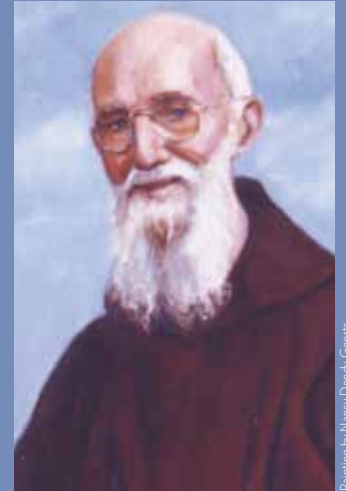
- Use your morning coffee time to read a Scripture verse.
- Recite the Rosary on your drive to work.

- Pray before (and even after) each meal.

Dear Parishioners,

As I write to you this week, all of us find ourselves in a strange and unfamiliar world. The world as we know it has been turned upside down. This week, the Bishops of Ohio, in response to the growing threat of the Coronavirus, have suspended all public Masses and liturgies, at least through Holy Week and Easter. This is something completely unprecedented and most uncomfortable. The dangerous Coronavirus is very contagious and spreads easily in gatherings of people, so all gatherings of more than a few people must be avoided. The suspension of public Masses is absolutely necessary to stem the spread of the virus, but not having the assembly of God's people present in church leaves me feeling disoriented, lost and sad. I can only imagine how you feel. We must endure this time when we are deprived of the consolation of gathering together for Mass and pray that God may hasten the day when the emergency has passed.

I do want to assure you that the priests of St. Andrew are offering Mass privately and we are fulfilling the Mass intentions which have been requested for each Mass. I urge everyone to unite themselves spiritually with the celebration of the Mass, even though you are not able to be present and may not actually receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Offer to God your prayers, works, joys and sufferings of each day "in union with the holy sacrifice of the Mass." Make an act of "Spiritual Communion." Remember that the priest who is celebrating the Mass is your representative before God. He "goes up to the altar of God" like Moses went up on Mount Sinai while the people stayed behind. Please know that our priests are remembering you at the altar. It is important that even though you cannot attend Mass or receive Communion on Sunday, and while the obligation continues to be dispensed, it is still important to "keep holy the Lord's day," especially through prayer. I urge you to spend time in prayer, to read and reflect upon the Sunday readings, to watch televised broadcasts of the Mass and use other resources to unite yourself and your family to the celebration of the Mass. Please remember to use the resources on the FORMED website ([standrewcolumbus.FORMED.org](http://standrewcolumbus.FORMED.org)) which all St. Andrew parishioners are entitled to use for free. There are many resources for all ages. Also, please don't forget to support St. Andrew Parish. There can be no Sunday collection during this time, but our expenses do continue.

Please be aware that Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and Confessions can be done during this time, but not in the usual manner. The number of persons permitted to be present for Baptisms, Funerals or Weddings is strictly limited. Confessions are possible for individuals upon request, but communal Penance Services are not being offered. Sacramental visits are only done for those who are in danger because of their health or are dying. Because of the danger of spreading the virus, ordinary routine visits to the homebound to bring Holy Communion are suspended. All other parish meetings, classes, gatherings and social events are suspended for the duration of this emergency.

The church will be open for prayer and devotion Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and Sunday from 12:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The church will be closed on Saturday. The church must remain locked during the hours when the priests are offering Mass in private.

Please see the list of resources elsewhere in this bulletin and other information that may be helpful. I look forward to the day when we will be reunited before the altar of God in our beautiful church of St. Andrew. Until then, may God protect you from all harm and keep you healthy and strong.
