Dear Parishioners and All,

On behalf of all the clergy of St. Andrew Parish, I wish each and every one of you a most blessed and happy Easter! This is the greatest feast day of the church year and of the Christian faith, that great feast celebrating our Savior's victory over sin and death. "Christ the Lord is risen on high, now he lives no more to die!" How I wish I could celebrate Easter Mass with all of you gathered in church, singing the praises of the Risen Christ, and chanting our Easter Alleluias! How I wish I could greet you in person and wish you a Happy Easter as I meet you coming to St. Andrew's Church for Easter services. I know that you are missing being able to gather for Mass at St. Andrew Parish with your fellow parishioners. You are missing the opportunity to partake of the Lord's Body and Blood in Holy Communion. You are also missing being part of a worshipping community in offering the Sacrifice of Praise to God the Father, through, with and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. This Easter, while we are still under the "stay at home" order for who knows how much longer, we may feel that, although Christ is risen from the dead, we ourselves are still locked in our "tombs." Although we celebrate Christ's victory this Easter Day, we may still feel discouraged because the eventual victory over the Coronavirus still seems far off. I encourage you to be patient, be hopeful, and be safe. Meanwhile, on this Easter feast, I urge you to celebrate the Lord's resurrection by renewing your baptismal promises at home, just like you would have done at Easter Mass. This is a most fitting way to celebrate Easter because, in baptism, we died with Christ and rose to new life with him as well. There is a formula you may follow to renew your baptismal promises included in today's bulletin.

Next weekend, April 18-19, is the weekend designated to implement the new Sunday Mass Schedule at St. Andrew. Since public masses are not being held, this may seem unimportant now. However, the priests will be offering masses privately according to the new schedule, and those wishing to unite spiritually with a particular mass will want to be aware. When at last we are able to have public masses again--whenever that may be--we do plan to follow the new Sunday schedule.





R. Amen.



FAQ About Scheduled Baptisms, Weddings and Events

We're receiving many calls and emails with questions regarding upcoming Baptisms, Weddings and other events.

In accordance with the governor's executive order, the Diocese announced that all public liturgies are canceled until further notice. This includes baptisms, funerals, and weddings.

Emergency sacraments are permitted; parishioners should contact the parish office at 614-451-4290 and leave a message on the sacramental emergency line in the case of a baptism or anointing needed in an urgent situation.

For Baptisms

Once we get notice that we are able to resume baptisms, those who had baptisms scheduled in March, April and May should contact the parish secretary, Kelly Nasdeo to reschedule. knasdeo@standrewparish.cc

For Weddings

If you would like to check on future dates, for the quickest response, email Kelly at knasdeo@standrewparish.cc and she will work with you on checking the availability on the church calendar of the dates in which you are interested. However for all other wedding related questions for weddings already scheduled should be directed to the clergy assigned to your wedding.

We appreciate your patience as we work through this. And while everything is a little uncertain at present, remember Philippians 4:6-7:
