## FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we observe Mothers' Day, and I want to wish all mothers, grandmothers, mothers-in-law, step-mothers, godmothers, and mothers-to-be a very Happy Mothers Day! May your children bless you, your families praise you, your friends and relatives honor you, and may God bless you! You mothers who have been at home with your families for these many weeks of "sheltering in place" have certainly exhibited heroic patience and dedication. If only your spouses and children could treat you to a nice dinner "out" at a fine restaurant to honor you. You are probably tired of eating "in" and getting bored with your own cooking. I know I am! About two weeks ago, a parish family delivered a nice meal to the rectory for Fr. Lehigh and me. The dinner included salad, pasta, meatballs and sauce, wine, and dessert. There was also a bottle of Italian salad dressing included. At first, I wasn't going to open the salad dressing because we already had some in the refrigerator. But then I decided to open and use the salad dressing that had been delivered with the meal, because, as I told Fr. Lehigh, we would pretend that we were dining out at "Ken's Steak House," since that was the brand name of the salad dressing! Oh, the things we do to keep ourselves from going crazy from boredom and losing hope.

In the past, we distributed flowers to all mothers at the weekend masses on Mother's Day. Obviously, we won't be doing that this weekend --but we will make a contribution to the Women's Care Center in honor of our mothers and to help the young mothers served by the Women's Care Center.

I do want to take this opportunity to thank all of you who have helped us "close the gap" by continuing your contributions to the St. Andrew Offertory during these difficult times. Our Sunday offertory dropped dramatically back in March when Masses were suspended, but lately have rebounded nicely in spite of the fact that there still are no public Masses and no "passing of the basket." But you have been using electronic giving, or mailing in or dropping off your offertory donations to the parish office, and I am VERY grateful. Please keep it up as you are able. Some of you have made some extra generous gifts as well and I profoundly thank you! St. Andrew parishioners are the best! I also want to inform you that St. Andrew Parish has applied for and received a loan through the Federally sponsored "Payroll Protection Program" of the Small Business Administration. We qualified for this loan because we are keeping our employees on the payroll during the time of idleness and reduced revenue due to the pandemic. This loan will also help us "close the gap" and will most likely be forgiven according to the terms of the federal program.

As we look forward to the possibility of once again having public Masses, hopefully by Pentecost Sunday (May 30/31), I ask you to continue to be patient. You have been tremendously patient for two months already. But as anticipation and eagerness to return to Mass and the sacraments grows, please continue to be calm. Even when Masses resume, we must still exercise extreme caution as the coronavirus is still a threat. Many of you may not wish to, or may not be able to return to Mass right away, especially if you are in a "high risk" category.

Let us continue to be faithful to God, faithful to the Holy Catholic Church, and faithful in prayer for one another throughout these days. May God bless you all!




Ultimately, that was enough for them to know. They would be with him. Strengthen your relationship with God as He is the way, the truth, and the life.

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Catholic Life Explained:

*Saints or Sinners?*

#### Question:

When reading about the lives of some saints, you may be struck by how some of them thought they were such sinners. Why would someone so holy think they had such serious sin?

#### Answer:

Professional athletes practice the fundamentals of their sport over and over again, reaching for better form, consistency, and performance. They focus on the basics, review past performances, and visualize greater success. Practice makes better, if not perfect!

Spiritual masters such as the saints also looked for perfection. They practiced their faith in the search for holiness, grace, and virtue. Through sacraments, prayer, study, good works, and penance, they raised their level of awareness and their sensitivity to the presence of God, the demands of the Gospel, and the workings of the Holy Spirit. They examined their consciences daily, reviewing the day for moments of failure and times that they could have been more virtuous in one way or another. They resolved to do better, be more attentive, and alert!

Therefore, anything that would distract them or interfere with their relationship with God would be like a small black spot on a bright white wall — you can't miss it! The great saints were aware of sin and the presence of evil because they were so tuned into the struggle between good and evil that was fought in their own lives, hearts, and souls.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When earthly lives end, especially when the person is younger, we tend to focus upon and consider what was lost. We think of lost opportunities — things they won't be able to see, babies they won't be able to cradle, and adventures that now must go undiscovered. Our minds create this chasm between earth and heaven that sees the losses of this life as permanent ones, never possible to achieve again. This perception causes many folks to remain stuck in their grief as they ponder all of the missed opportunities and regrets.

This is not resurrection thinking. All of the love that we can give and receive, the joy and elation that can be experienced, the adventures that can be undertaken, and the possibilities to be discovered are all part of a continuous journey. They are not ends in and of themselves but are all part of the unfolding of a relationship we have with God, who not only makes all of these wonderful things possible now but sustains them and fulfills them into eternity. The perception and experience of loss is really



an illusion, because in God's eternal kingdom and in God's time, nothing is ever lost. Even the most intimate and tender of moments we can conceive of sharing with another human being are only part of a journey toward perfect intimate and tender moments to be shared with God in our resurrected life. We become like God and see God as He is in eternity. What greater joy, love, and hope can ever be discovered as we walk down our often dimly lit paths in this world.

This is an awesome wonder and magnificent news to behold. Call to mind someone you have lost in death. How do you see them now? How do you see yourself in heaven? Remind yourself, again, that God is the Way, the Truth and the Life. Our happiness is not

going to be fully realized in this world, and there is nothing we can find here that cannot be found one hundred-fold in eternity. It's all about relationship, and not solely about the relationships we have with each other, ourselves, and the world in which we live. It's about our relationship with God. If we realize how special that one relationship really is, then there is only one particular of heaven and life eternal that really matters: namely, that we fall into love eternal and discover truth. For when we finally close our eyes in death, then all will be well as long as we are with God. There are no losses, only gains.


