## FROM THE PASTOR

### Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, and this week we celebrate Memorial Day on Monday, May 25. Memorial Day is considered the unofficial beginning of Summer. More importantly, we remember and honor those who died in the service of our country. And likewise, we remember all of our deceased loved ones who have gone before us. "Remembering" is a very powerful and sacred activity. I have been considering that lately as I celebrate Mass, all alone at the altar, and remember all of you and commend you in prayer to the Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Each Mass includes an explicit "remembrance" of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus our Savior. The Eucharist is actually called the "Memorial" of his death and resurrection. After we "remember" the Lord's death and victory over death, we then ask God the Father to "remember"

the Church throughout the world and to "remember" our deceased brothers and sisters. Certainly, He could never forget them! And so, our Memorial Day remembrances are also sacred and powerful. While we are calling to mind so many who have passed from this world, let us also remember those who have died from COVID19 illness, and also those of our parish and others who died during this time who were unable to receive full funeral honors because of the restrictions on Mass gatherings. May we not forget any of these but remember them with tenderness and affection.

On Tuesday of this week, we will resume the celebration of daily Masses in public at St. Andrew Church, at 6:30 and 8:30 a.m. This will give us a chance to celebrate Mass, observing all of the precautions that must be followed, and see how it goes—I hope smoothly. I hope this will help us get all the "bugs" out and get comfortable with the different way of celebrating Mass before the weekend comes, which will be the true test! I am a little nervous

about how the weekend will go. I hope that we do not have too many people trying to attend any of the Masses, as the number allowed in the church is strictly limited. And I am hoping that all who do attend obey all the rules of social distancing, hand sanitizing, and wearing the necessary face covering or mask for the protection of themselves and others from the virus. I certainly don't want to encounter any unpleasantness, resistance, or disregard for these rules. I firmly believe that these measures are not burdensome and are the very least we can do to help prevent the spread of the virus when we come together for Mass. It is our moral responsibility to do this.

By the way, the priests are still available to hear confessions by appointment. We are not yet ready to begin regular confessions on Saturdays, but we will communicate our plans to do this in the near future as we are able.

The Easter season is almost over. This season is always a tougher one for us Catholics. We get Advent and Lent: preparation. We are on board with Christmas, mainly because we like to keep up our decorations until someone tells us the exact day we must take them down. But Easter as a season is a bit more difficult to observe. The rest of the world has moved on. There are no Easter eggs left in store windows and all those religious movies on television have given way to reruns or season-ending episodes. It just feels like Easter anywhere ...except in the Church.

The truth is that it should feel like Easter all year-round in the Church. Every Sunday, we celebrate a mini-Easter. Our Lord is ALIVE! He is risen and alive, and we need to celebrate. We also need to be about the work of the Lord. We are an Easter people who bear witness to his resurrection through our stewardship. If he had never risen, then we would be called to nothing by no one. But he lives! As this Easter season is drawing to a close, it is prudent to reflect on what his death and resurrection mean for each of us. How has it changed us? How does it motivate us? It doesn't look like Easter in most corners of the world, so it is up to us to bring a little Easter to every place we go and to everyone we meet.

**WHY DO WE DO THAT?**  
**Catholic Life Explained:**  
*Kneel at Mass*

### Question:

Why do we kneel at Mass?

### Answer:

Since the beginnings of the Church, kneeling has been a key posture of prayer. We see Sts. Peter and Paul in the Acts of the Apostles kneeling in prayer. Early in the 4th century, the Council of Nicaea prohibited kneeling on Sundays and special feasts. Kneeling began more as a posture of penance for our sins, but in the history of the Church, it has become more a posture of reverence and solemn prayer.

You will notice that the times we kneel at Mass are tied to the consecration of the holy Eucharist. We kneel in both anticipation of what will occur and then in awe of what has taken place: Jesus Christ becomes truly present to us under the guise of bread and wine. The profoundness of this event has over time led the Church to mandate in the current General Instruction of the Roman Missal that kneeling is the only posture allowed during this time. The sheer awesomeness of the holy Eucharist leads us to fall to our knees in wonder and thanksgiving.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

What does faith and religion do for us? Ultimately, they remind us of some truths we conveniently forget: we are created by a loving God, we have imperfections, we sin, we need to be forgiven, we have a mission and a purpose, it's not just about us, and we hunger for the joy of salvation. These are human truths that are not dependent upon whether we like them. Ignoring them places us on the paths of comfort and satisfaction as we blindly pursue the busyness and superficiality of our empty lives. Instead of pursuing supernatural and lasting pleasure, we choose things that are easier and quicker to obtain: sex, drugs, travel, houses, cars, fame, popularity, self-achievement and satisfaction, physical enjoyment, and the like.

We may also find ourselves falling victim to more negative responses to what life brings us: anger, envy, lust, pride, gluttony, greed, and apathy. Human hearts can become so hardened to the truth that violence becomes the response of first choice. Being a Christian is hard! Yet, as Pope Francis reminds us, the Church needs to be a field hospital that has to be prepared to provide



people with the remedy they need. What we need is Jesus Christ. The Church, with all of the glory of the sacraments, exists to help make Christ present and real for us. Once we find Christ, we find joy. Joy is a matter of the heart that is beyond pleasure and happiness. It is not found in some earthly satisfaction, only in Christ.

Once we accept that we are destined to be in Christ, then we will discover eternal life. Namely, "that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ." It is easy to conveniently forget truth and pursue illusions immediately within our grasp, but at what price? A man celebrating 60 years of marriage remarked that it took so

much effort and so many attempts to convince his wife that they were meant to be together. Even his friends told him he was foolish. He easily could have given up and pursued other interests. He chose to persevere and is so grateful that he made that choice because he now has a pearl of great price. Do we see a value in persevering in our faith regardless of the cost? If we don't take the risk, we could lose more than we know.

## HOW TO WEAR A MASK

Keeping a distance (at least six feet) from other people is our best protection against COVID-19; however, wearing a facemask can add another layer of protection. Masks can help protect others by containing respiratory droplets when the mask wearer coughs, sneezes or speaks.

Wearing a cloth face covering does not replace social/physical distancing, practicing good hygiene, and staying home when sick. These are the most important steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19 illness and other illnesses.

Cloth face coverings should be changed when damp and washed and dried after each use. Coverings that have been worn may be contaminated.

- **Always wash your hands** before putting on a mask and after removing a mask.
- **Do not touch the front** of the face mask, especially when you take it off. Always use the loops or elastic.
- **Make sure your mask fits** tightly around your nose and face.
- **Change your mask frequently** when it becomes damp.
- **If you are using a reusable cloth mask**, always wash & dry your mask every day.
- **Wash your hands frequently, don't touch your face and stay home when you are ill.**
