FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I have been noticing lately the sounds of locusts or cicadas singing, reminding me that Fall is not far away. When I hear that sound, it never fails to take me back to my childhood. The sound of the locusts in the Summer was a reminder that the carefree days of summer vacation were coming to a close. It was a sign that school would be starting soon. The sound of locusts singing is nostalgic to me, but also somewhat melancholy. Indeed, time marches on. Fall will be here soon. A few short weeks from now it will be Labor Day. 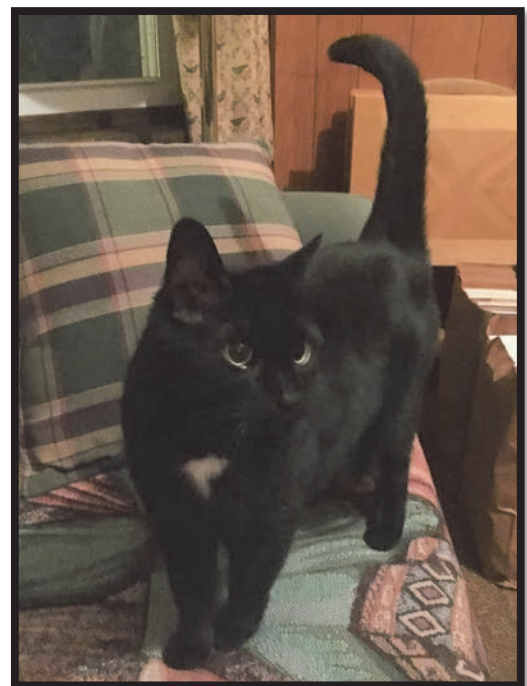
THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

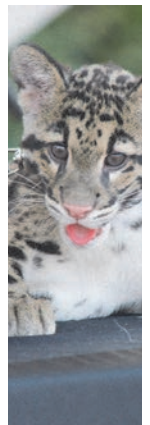
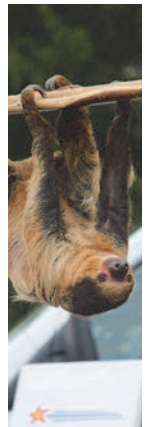

SCHEDULING MASS INTENTIONS

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a loved one – living or deceased – is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition and to ensure all who wish to schedule a Mass for loved ones may do so, **a new Mass Intention procedure has been put into effect immediately.**

- † All Mass Intention requests should be made in writing and must be accompanied by payment. While you may call or email to check the availability of certain dates or times, requests will not be finalized and will not be reserved until payment is received.
- † A \$10 stipend, as determined by Diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass request.
- † Only one intention (person) per Mass is permitted, however for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of parishioners, two first names (David & Catherine Smith) or two last names (Davis & Smith Families) are acceptable.
- † Once scheduled, we will send a list of the Masses scheduled for your records. Please allow 5-7 days.
- † Families may schedule up to twelve (12) Masses per year with four (4) of those on weekends. Additional Masses will be accepted, but these will be scheduled when dates are available throughout the year on a rotating basis.
- † Questions? Please email the parish secretary at knasdeo@standrewparish.cc or call the parish office at 614-451-4290

1. Your name & contact information (email and/or phone number)
2. The name of the person for whom the Mass is being requested
3. The date(s) and time(s) requested for each Mass. You may include an alternative date or time for us to check if the date/time is not available. We will do our best to honor the dates/times requested, but unfortunately, no date or time can be guaranteed.
4. A check made payable to St. Andrew Parish. As per Diocesan policy, a \$10 stipend per Mass is to accompany each request. Please write the words "Mass Intention" in the memo line of your check.

Due to the continuing uncertainty and rapidly spreading COVID 19 virus, we are not accepting reservations for use or rental of any of the meeting rooms or spaces around the parish for the near future.



Q: WHY ARE CATHOLICS REQUIRED TO GIVE MONEY TO THE CHURCH?

A: Offering money and other goods to God and the Church is, before all else, a statement of gratitude. We see this when we look at how our spiritual ancestors showed their gratitude to God for the gifts they had received (e.g. Genesis 14:18-20 and Genesis 28:16-22). One of the ways they offered thanks to God was through a practice called "tithing," in which 10 percent of a person's goods (crops, livestock, money, etc.) were given back to God.

Today, the practice of tithing — giving 10 percent — is still common in many Protestant communities, but it is not required for Catholics. Instead, the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that, "The faithful also have the duty of providing for the material needs of the Church, each according to [their] own abilities" (no. 2043). This means that, although we are not bound to practice "tithing" in the traditional sense, we do share a responsibility to share our money or other resources with our parish communities. Like our spiritual ancestors, we give as a sign of our gratitude for the many gifts that God has given to us. Beyond this, we also share our resources with other Catholic organizations to help them finance their ministries, to continue and grow their outreach to the poor and the needy, and to provide just wages for their employees.

How much we give depends on our individual circumstances, but since we share a responsibility for the programs, outreach, and health of our parish communities and Catholic organizations, this question gives us a wonderful opportunity to ask some important questions about the quality of our giving and what our priorities are. Remember, we are only stewards of our time, talents, and treasures and as the First Letter of Peter reminds us, "As each one of you has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied graces" (4:10).
