## FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I have a mixed bag of information for you this week.

First of all, as I am sure everyone knows by now, the entire State of Ohio is under a mandatory mask order, meaning everyone (with very few exceptions) must wear a mask or cloth face covering when out in public, both when inside and even outside when social distancing is not possible. The good news is that our precautions here at St. Andrew are already in conformity with this mandate. And I am pleased that almost everyone coming to church has been carefully complying with the rules by wearing their masks and keeping their distance. So, the State mandate doesn't really change much for us--except one thing: because the wearing of masks is now required by the governor's order and is no longer voluntary, if we fail to enforce the rule, St. Andrew Parish and its Pastor could be in trouble! So, I am really hoping to see

100% compliance with the wearing of masks here at St. Andrew's. Most of all, I want everyone to remain healthy.

Secondly, I want to thank those who have already pledged to this year's Bishop's Annual Appeal. We are already off to a good start. We have received more than \$88,000 in pledges toward our goal of \$210,135. That is about 42% of our goal. This is actually better than I expected and gives me hope that we will actually reach our goal this year, despite the difficult economic circumstances we are in. If we do reach and exceed our goal, I will apply the refund to help complete our video project for live-streaming our Masses. I am grateful to The Catholic Foundation for a grant of \$5,000 for this project. But it will take a bit more to bring it to completion. Keep those pledges coming!

Third item: **Next weekend, August 8-9**, is the annual Missionary Appeal. This year, the missionary appeal is for the Brothers of the Sacred Heart, a missionary congregation that serves youth in several African countries where they staff schools and other institutions.

Normally, one of the brothers would be present and speak at all the Masses, telling of the missionary work done by the congregation and asking for support for their work. A second collection would be taken up, and you would as always be very generous! But, of course, the pandemic has changed everything this year. Due to travel restrictions and virus precautions, the Brothers cannot be here in person to tell us about their work and their needs. So, they are asking the priests of St. Andrew to make the appeal on their behalf. Fr. Ferguson, Fr. DeVille, and I will do our best. There is some information in the bulletin about the Brothers of the Sacred Heart. I hope you will be generous. We will have special collection baskets for the missionary appeal in church, and you may also donate via online giving, or directly to the parish office by mail.

Thank you for your attention to all of this.

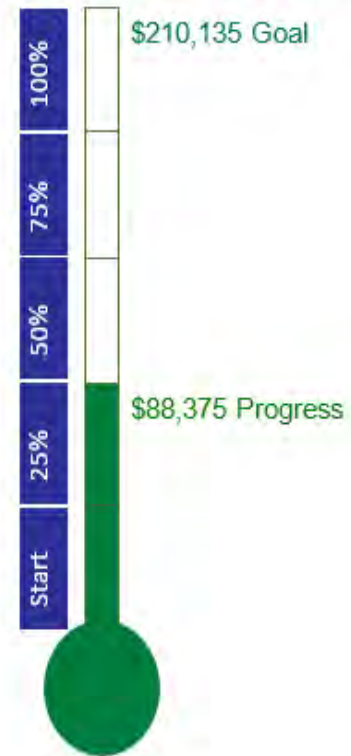

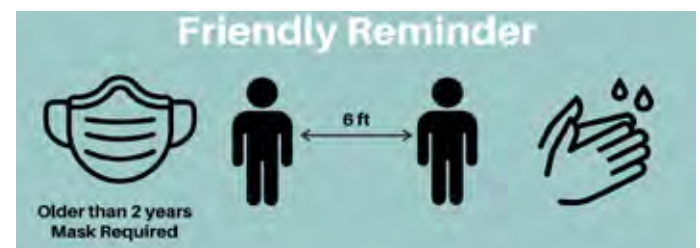
## Living "I Do"

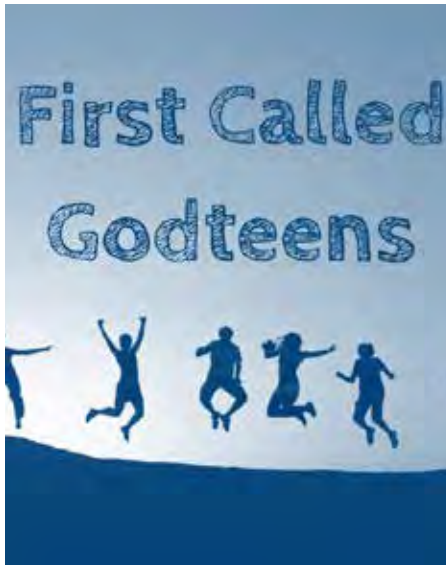

## SCHEDULING MASS INTENTIONS

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a loved one – living or deceased – is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition and to ensure all who wish to schedule a Mass for loved ones may do so, **a new Mass Intention procedure has been put into effect immediately.**

- † All Mass Intention requests should be made in writing or in person (at the present time due to limited office staffing, we are not currently taking in person requests) & must be accompanied by payment. **While you may call or email to check the availability of certain dates or times, requests will not be finalized over the phone and will not be reserved until payment is received.**
- † Request forms are available in the pamphlet racks in the parlor and NW entrance or you may send an email or note (accompanied with payment) with the name(s) of the deceased, dates & times requested and your contact information. Only one intention (person) per Mass is allowed, however for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of parishioners, two first names (David & Catherine Smith) or two last names (Davis & Smith Families) are acceptable.
- † We will do our best to honor the date(s) & times requested, but unfortunately, no date or time can be guaranteed. Once scheduled, we will send a list of the Masses scheduled for your records. You will be sent a confirmation of the date(s) and time(s) of the Mass(es) scheduled. Please allow 5-7 days for processing.
- † Families may schedule up to twelve (12) Masses per year with four (4) of those on weekends. Additional Masses will be accepted, but these will be scheduled when dates are available throughout the year on a rotating basis.
- † A \$10 stipend, as determined by Diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass request. **Please make check payable to St. Andrew Parish** with Mass Stipend in memo section of check. Payment, along with request form or note with Mass dates/times requested may be placed in an envelope marked "Mass Intentions" & placed in the weekend collection basket or mailed to the parish office at St. Andrew Parish, Attn: Mass Intentions, 1899 McCoy Rd., Columbus, OH 43220.

Hello! I hope you are all having a wonderful Summer!!!! I wanted to announce our new High School Ministry Program called Godteens here at St. Andrew!!! The Godteens ministry is something I grew up with at my home parish in Nebraska and was the coordinator for back in Nebraska a few years ago and I am excited to bring this format to St. Andrews this year! What is different about Godteens is that it is very small group focused and based off of student's grade levels!! I think it allows for some more deep discussion and fellowship among smaller groups of students and I think this format will work very well in the COVID world we are currently living in because it is all small group based!

#### *What is Godteens?*

Each high school student that signs up will be assigned to a small group with two Godparent Leaders (one adult male and one adult female) for the year based off of their high school grade level! They will meet in their HS Godteen Group two to three times a month starting in September-May. Once a month, all the Godteen Groups will meet together either virtually or in person, depending on COVID!

#### *Where will Godteens meet?*

Depending on COVID this year, these meetings can be virtual Zoom or in person, COVID permitting.

*When will Godteens meet?* 6:30-8pm on Sundays. If there are a lot of conflicts for students at this time, we can look at arranging other HS Godteen groups on different evenings and times if there is enough interest. Once a month all the Godteen Groups will meet together either virtually or in person depending on COVID!

#### *Who are Godparents?*

We are looking for at least four couples to be Godparent Leaders together. You do not need to be married or dating. It could be just an adult man and a woman who are good friends. We would like one adult woman and one adult man per group together, at least 18 years or older and a high school graduate. We are looking for adults who love Jesus and their Catholic faith, love to have lots of fun and who are excited to share the Catholic faith with the next generation! All Godparents will need to have completed the Protecting Gods

*Children Training and background check.* My husband and I were Godteen Parent leaders together for a few years and it was a lot of fun to do together and really good for our marriage! If you have young kids, they are welcome to join in with you and do not feel like you need to have a babysitter each week in order to serve as a godparent. Exposing teens to what a true Catholic married and family life looks like with your children can be a super cool part of your ministry.

*What will we talk about in Godteens?* The cool part about Godteens is that you can focus on what you and your small group would like to study and learn more deeply about. It could be a particular Bible study, book study, apologetics, salvation history, Worship, Marian Concentration, Theology of the Body, Y Disciple, etc. Godparents will meet with Andrea and discuss different options on what their small group would like to focus on throughout the year!!! Since every group will be very different, we will cater to what your individual small group would like to focus on!

### WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:

### WHY DO CATHOLICS GO TO MASS EVERY SUNDAY?

The heart of the Church's instruction that we are to attend Mass on Sundays goes back to the Third Commandment: "Take care to keep holy the sabbath day as the LORD, your God, has commanded you" (Deuteronomy 5:12). Although the Jewish People celebrate the Sabbath on Saturday, the first generations of Christians began to observe the sabbath on Sunday, recognizing how important it is for Christians to celebrate the day that Jesus rose from the dead. As the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults observes, "Sunday extends the celebration of Easter throughout the year ... It makes present the new creation brought about by Christ" (364).

The focus of our Sunday should be the celebration of the Eucharist in the Mass. This is our time to be formed by God's Word and nourished at the table of the Lord, becoming prepared to live out and share our faith in the week that follows. In his encyclical, *Dies Domini*, Pope Saint John Paul II reminded us that Christians "cannot live their faith or share fully in the life of the Christian community unless they take part regularly in the Sunday Eucharistic assembly" (no. 81). This is why the Church teaches us that Sunday Mass is a non-negotiable part of being a Christian (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2192).

Beyond being a time of worship, we should also remember that Sunday is intended to be a day of rest, when we make time for recreation, for sharing meals, and enjoying the company of friends and family. Sunday is given to us as a day to take stock of and enjoy the blessings that God has given us (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2187). Pope Francis reminds us, "The day of rest, centered on the Eucharist, sheds its light on the whole week, and motivates us to greater concern for nature and the poor" (*Laudato Si'*, no. 237).

I remember seeing a story on a morning news program about a little girl who wanted to give an elderly man in a grocery store a hug. She had no way of knowing that this man had just lost his wife of many years and now felt so very alone and depressed. Her reaching out to the man seemed odd to her mom at first, but the girl was so insistent about giving a hug she moved the shopping carts close together so the exchange could take place. No one knew that from that moment on the little girl would ask to visit her new friend at least once a week for the next four years until he passed away. In an interview soon after the initial encounter, the man said, "I haven't been this happy in some time." Imagine the joy that relationship brought to them both over the years! It was just a moment. It was a simple gesture. Yet, it had a large impact that no one could have predicted. You never know what will result when we give

just a little of ourselves. That uncertainty too often leads us to hold back or refrain from the simple actions of love or gestures of generosity that could come so easily for us if we wanted. We should never doubt the power of a simple random act of kindness. Generosity does not need to be grand to make a big difference. The time is now, and the opportunity presents itself often to plant a small seed that God can water and nourish so that something beautiful can grow.
