## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This week we observe the feasts of several saints whose holy lives and example are relevant and inspiring for us 21st century Catholics.

**Thursday, August 27, and**

**Friday, August 28** are the memorials of St. Monica and St. Augustine, mother and son.

We learn about St. Monica mostly from Augustine's autobiography, known as "The Confessions of St. Augustine." It is really the story of his search for truth and his conversion from sin and error to the Catholic faith. Augustine relates how his mother Monica prayed relentlessly for her son to turn from his wayward path and embrace the true faith, to be baptized and saved. Of course, Augustine eventually professed Christianity and was baptized by St. Ambrose. Augustine became a bishop, a great theologian, and a Doctor of the Church. And St. Monica is the model and exemplar for all parents who worry about their wayward sons and daughters who have strayed away from the practice of the faith and pray for them ceaselessly that they may return to the church. St. Monica's example teaches us to never give up and to keep praying!

**On Saturday, August 29,** we celebrate the martyrdom of

St. John the Baptist. John the Baptist was beheaded because he witnessed to the sanctity of marriage. He had told King Herod, "it is not right

for you to have your brother's wife." Herod had "married" Herodias, the wife of his brother Philip. Herodias resented John's interference and criticism and wanted to kill him. She eventually succeeded with the help of her daughter, whom she convinced to ask for the head of John the Baptist when Herod offered to give her anything she asked for. John the Baptist is thus the model and exemplar for those who teach and witness to the sanctity of marriage in our society today, and who risk suffering hostility, insult, and persecution for doing so. The solemn teaching of Jesus on this subject in his own words establishes the principle that marriage is a union of one man and one woman which is indissoluble. Jesus Himself says "what God has joined, let no human being separate," and "a man who divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her, and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery" (Mk 10:9-12). Many people today--even those who profess to follow Christ--reject this understanding of marriage. It is risky to witness to the Lord's and the Church's teaching on marriage, but the example of John the Baptist inspires us and gives us courage.

I want to encourage all of you this week in your pursuit of holiness to follow the example of the saints. May you be blessed in these August days!



## SCHEDULING MASS INTENTIONS



The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a loved one – living or deceased – is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition and to ensure all who wish to schedule a Mass for loved ones may do so, a new Mass Intention procedure has been put into effect immediately.

- † All Mass Intention requests should be made in writing and must be accompanied by payment. While you may call or email to check the availability of certain dates or times, requests will not be finalized and will not be reserved until payment is received.
- † A \$10 stipend, as determined by Diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass request.
- † Only one intention (person) per Mass is permitted, however, for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of parishioners, two first names (David & Catherine Smith) or two last names (Davis & Smith Families) are acceptable.
- † Once scheduled, we will send a list of the Masses scheduled for your records. Please allow 5-7 days.
- † Families may schedule up to twelve (12) Masses per year with four (4) of those on weekends. Additional Masses will be accepted, but these will be scheduled when dates are available throughout the year on a rotating basis.






## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

## GOSPEL MEDITATION


### ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The only way to know God is to love God. Our minds will never fully grasp the mystery of God, but our hearts and souls can learn to love the mystery. Years ago, when life had a more innocent quality to it, we believed what we were told or witnessed, unless there was direct evidence otherwise. This was especially true if the information came from someone in authority. In a sense, we were a bit more gullible on one hand but also more trusting on the other. The latter is an admirable quality that sadly can be eroded when we realize we have been duped. With education and technological advances, we find ourselves more skeptical and less likely to too quickly accept and believe what we see and hear.


For all of the good that social media can do, it can also easily distort reality and truth. Photoshop and a myriad of other technological truths can add to, fabricate, and make even the non-existent seem real. It is amazing. How far do we allow this obviously justifiable skepticism to

take us? Questioning and doubting are healthy elements of any good relationship as long as we don't allow them to turn us away from a deeper experience of love and encounter. If we cannot get our minds around something or empirically justify or prove it, we tend to declare it a hoax, untrue, or unauthentic and walk away. The very same trust that can quickly be eroded is exactly what is essential for all of our relationships, especially our relationship with God. With all things and people that make a profound claim on us, we have to trust in the absence of knowledge. Full self-investment involves plunging completely into the unknown!

Simon Peter said to Jesus, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Peter came to this knowledge, which is not "head knowledge" because of the relationship he shared with Jesus and what God was able to reveal in and through that relationship. Peter simply "knew" because of love that this is who Jesus really



is. The silent exchange of love between friends, and not an intellectual exercise of the mind, brought Peter to this place. When we stop and think about it, there are many things in life that we simply know but do not completely understand. When someone sacrifices their own well-being for another, it may not make intellectual sense when examined. But it makes a world of sense when it is carried out. The vastness of reality and an encounter with incomprehensible mystery all lead us to profound silence where we simply know something to be true. Have you trusted enough to allow your relationship with God to bring you to this place or are you still too skeptical?

What does it mean to be a good steward? Does it mean to be an active parishioner, or something more? Are we better stewards because we give more in terms of our money and time to our parish, or are we called to do even more than that?

The truth is that stewardship is a way of life. We are not simply called to be active parishioners, but instead, be active disciples all the time. In fact, what we learn to do in our parish should serve as preparation for the mission field of the world. What have we really done if we only act like disciples of Jesus Christ while we are assembled with others who claim to be the same?

The choice before us is to give of ourselves in all aspects of our day and life. The call of Jesus will come in our everyday lives with our co-workers, family, and friends more often than it will within our parish community.

First, if we can't become good stewards when we are among those who proclaim Jesus as Lord, how will we be able to do so when we are with those who are non-believers? Second, when our muscles of gratitude, generosity, and graciousness are strengthened within our parish community, we are more able to meet the challenges of this world. However, we do not become good stewards by accident. We must always choose to live this way. What will you choose?



## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Catholic Life Explained:

**Q:** *In the Nicene Creed, we recite that Christ “will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead.” But many of us assume that we are judged individually (and hopefully off to heaven) at the moment of our death. So which is it — are we judged by God as soon as we die or is it later, at Christ’s return?*

**A.** Both are true. The Catholic Church has always believed in a twofold judgment by God: a particular judgment at the moment of death and a general judgment at the end of time.

So immediately when we die, each individual is judged as either worthy of eternal life in heaven (there may be a temporary stop in purgatory for purification from the remnants of sin) or deserving of eternal punishment in hell.

In the words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: “Each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul at the very moment of his death, in a particular judgment that refers his life to Christ” (No. 1022). That particular judgment will be private.

But then at the end of the world, when Jesus returns in glory, there will be a public “general” judgment at which each one’s particular judgment will be confirmed and revealed to all. Again, in the words of the catechism: “The Last Judgment will reveal even to its furthest consequences the good each person has done or failed to do during his earthly life” (No. 1039).


