LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I want to congratulate our First Communicants who have received or will soon receive their First Holy Communion. We are having three separate First Communion Masses on these Saturdays in September: September 12, 19, and 26. Of course, our First Communion Mass that would have taken place last May was one of the casualties of the Coronavirus pandemic and the "shutdown" period when we weren't having any public Masses.

Now that we are finally celebrating First Communion, we still have to practice social distancing and limit the number of people attending, so we must divide into three groups rather than have one big First Communion Mass. I remarked to the First Communicants last Saturday that they have been waiting a very long time to receive the Bread of Life, and so they must be very hungry! The longer we must wait before we can eat, the hungrier we become. I asked the children to

remember their First Holy Communion all their lives and remember how long they had to wait for it. And I expressed my hope that they would always hunger for the Bread of Life!

I realize that many of you have also been waiting a long time to receive Holy Communion. You may be sheltering at home for your own safety and not wishing to take any chances with the Coronavirus which is still a threat. Although you are being prudent in staying away from gatherings and crowds, including at church, still you are waiting and getting hungrier and hungrier.

Perhaps you may watch a broadcast or livestream Mass, but even this only makes you realize that there is no substitute for being present at Mass and partaking of the Sacrament of the Eucharist. When this pandemic passes and we can all gather for Mass together and partake of the Lord's Body and Blood, I hope that you will never forget these days and always hunger for the Bread of Life!

SCHEDULING MASS INTENTIONS

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a loved one – living or deceased – is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition and to ensure all who wish to schedule a Mass for loved ones may do so, please note our Mass Intention Policy:

- † All Mass Intention requests should be made in writing must be accompanied by payment. While you may call or email to check the availability of certain dates or times, requests will not be finalized and will not be reserved until payment is received.
- † Only one intention (person) per Mass is permitted, however for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of parishioners, two first names (David & Catherine Smith) or two last names (Davis & Smith Families) are acceptable.
- † Once scheduled, we will send a list of the Masses scheduled for your records. **Please allow 5-7 days for processing from the date your request was received.**
- † Families may schedule up to twelve (12) Masses per year with four (4) of those on weekends. Additional Masses will be accepted, but these will be scheduled when dates are available throughout the year on a rotating basis.

In your request include:

1. Your name & contact information (email and/or phone number)
2. The name of the person for whom the Mass is being offered/requested (and whether they are living or deceased)
3. The date(s) and time(s) requested for each Mass. You may include an alternative date or time for us to check if the original date/time is not available. *We will do our best to honor the dates/times requested, but unfortunately, no date or time can be guaranteed*
4. A check made payable to St. Andrew Parish. As per Diocesan policy, a \$10 stipend per Mass is to accompany each request. Please write the words "Mass Intention" in the memo line of your check. Please do not send cash through the mail or leave it in any unsecured location.
5. If you would like Mass cards to send to friends or family, please list the number of cards you would like & they will be mailed to the address you provide.






