LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

The First of October is just around the corner--it falls on Thursday of this week. October is a beautiful month, but the nip in the air and the falling leaves remind us that Winter is coming. As we stand on October's doorstep, we are also aware that we have been living with the COVID-19 threat for a full six months now! That's half a year. That is two entire seasons--all of Spring and all of Summer. Furthermore, there is no end in sight. We may have to endure these uncomfortable conditions for another six months--all of Autumn and all of Winter. Let us pray for perseverance and patience. We do not want to become careless with our precautions and so risk becoming ill ourselves or making others ill.

October is Respect Life Month. As Catholics, we are called to defend the sanctity of life from conception to natural death. We are called to advocate for the legal protection of the unborn and to oppose the grave evil of abortion. We are called to oppose the death penalty, euthanasia, and assisted suicide. October is also the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary. What better way to improve our habits of prayer and raise our thoughts and aspirations to heavenly realities than to pray the Rosary! Especially in these times when our church activity is limited, the Rosary can be a great help to keep our prayer life focused and nourish our spirits.

Next Sunday, October 4th, is the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. Continuing the tradition of blessing animals on this day, I will again offer the opportunity for the Blessing of Pets. This will take place Sunday, October 4 at 3:00 p.m. on the front lawn of the Rectory, weather permitting. The blessing will take place outdoors, obviously, but we will still observe social distancing and wear our masks for safety. But you are invited to bring your pet to be blessed next Sunday. Mabel and I look forward to seeing you and invoking the blessing and protection of St. Francis upon all of our animal friends.

FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN



- † All Mass Intention requests should be made in writing must be accompanied by payment. While you may call or email to check the availability of certain dates or times, requests will not be finalized and will not be reserved until payment is received.
- † Only one intention (person) per Mass is permitted, however for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of parishioners, two first names (David & Catherine Smith) or two last names (Davis & Smith Families) are acceptable.
- † Once scheduled, we will send a list of the Masses scheduled for your records. **Please allow 5-7 days for processing from the date your request was received.**
- † Families may schedule up to twelve (12) Masses per year with four (4) of those on weekends. Additional Masses will be accepted, but these will be scheduled when dates are available throughout the year on a rotating basis.


