LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

One day about two weeks ago, I was doing some shopping errands. I was at a local store and purchased some masks, some hand sanitizer, and some dog food – essential pandemic supplies! While I was shopping, I noticed that the store was beginning to display Christmas items. Although it seemed early to be thinking about Christmas, the truth is, Christmas had already been on my mind for about six weeks. I have been thinking a lot about Christmas – in particular, how St. Andrew Parish will prepare for Christmas Masses while the COVID-19 threat persists. It is becoming increasingly evident to me that the Coronavirus will not be past and gone by Christmas. Rather, I predict that there will not yet be a vaccine widely available in December. I predict that social distancing, the wearing of masks, the use of sanitizer, and the disinfecting of surfaces before and after every Mass will still be required. I predict that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will still be in effect at Christmas, and that those people in a higher risk category will still be strongly encouraged to avoid large crowds and discouraged from attending Church. I predict that the maximum number of people allowed in St. Andrew Church will still be 300, and that every other pew will still be closed to insure proper distancing. I predict that the doors of the church will still be standing open and that the temperature will be frigid. I predict that there will be very little of the traditional pageantry and ceremony we are accustomed to at any of our Christmas Masses: there will be no choir, no choristers, no fanfare, no choral program or carol singing, no incense, no blessing of the Christmas

crib – only simple Masses celebrated in the manner that has become the “new normal” on Sundays. I predict that these Masses will be livestreamed so they can be viewed at home. I predict that the Parish Hall will not be available to have a second Mass because that space will still be occupied by classrooms. And I am worried because Christmas Masses, especially vigil Masses, usually attract huge crowds that we can barely accommodate even when there are no restrictions. What will happen if 1,000 or more people show up for the 4:00 vigil Mass on Christmas Eve, and we only have room for 300? I am afraid there may be a riot!

I have shared my worries with other priests, with the Bishop, and with our Liturgy Committee. We have considered a variety of options – like requiring reservations and tickets, or having loudspeakers outside, or having an “overflow” area in the gym with another Mass. Before making any final decisions on how to prepare, the Liturgy Committee suggested taking a survey to find out what our parishioners would intend to do about attending Christmas Mass “in person” while the pandemic threat continues. Elsewhere in this bulletin today, you will find information about this survey. I really need everyone to respond to this survey and let me know your intentions regarding Christmas Mass attendance given all of the factors I predicted above. The survey is short and easy and the information you provide will be very helpful as we make decisions about our Christmas Vigil and Christmas Day Masses. Deadline for completing the survey is October 25. Thank You for responding to this survey. Stay tuned for further developments!



THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN


by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



ST. CHARLES HOLDING PRIVATE FAMILY TOURS


