LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

One afternoon this past week, I was praying Vespers from the Liturgy of the Hours. I happened to be sitting outside in the back yard of the rectory as I was praying. It was a beautiful October day. The sun was shining, the sky was blue, and the leaves on the trees were showing their autumn colors as they rustled in the breeze. As a priest, I have an obligation to pray the Liturgy of the Hours or the "Divine Office" every day, and I usually pray the evening portion around 5:00 p.m. in the afternoon, after I come back to St. Andrew's from my work at the Chancery of the Diocese. That little period of prayer and rest is a refreshing pause in the busy day. On this particular day, however, I noticed that, as I was praying, I frequently looked up at the sky. That is not unusual, of course, but I became aware of something that I do unconsciously, and began to reflect upon it. I thought about the fact that the Gospels tell us that when Jesus prayed, He "raised His eyes to heaven." Jesus taught us to pray to "Our Father who art in heaven." When Jesus ascended into heaven, He was lifted up and disappeared behind a cloud, and His disciples continued to stare at the sky. Heaven is God's dwelling, and although we know that heaven is not located somewhere in the sky in our universe, nevertheless, heaven is "above" so it is appropriate that we look upwards "to heaven" when we pray.

I also reflected that I was truly in a sacred place as I was praying beneath the sky, because I was looking up at God's dwelling, His sanctuary. When I am in church praying, I am in God's house, His dwelling, and I am aware of the Lord's true presence in the Tabernacle. But even away from church, I am in the presence of God, and I am reminded of this whenever I raise my eyes to heaven.

I share this with you today in case you may find it helpful in your own habits of prayer.

May God bless you and protect you all your days!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie" and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. A couple of weeks ago, I was meowing to you about how much God wants you to meow...errr...to talk to Him all the time. And when we talk to God, and when we listen to God, we call that "prayer." That's right. I said that some prayers we say are those that we memorize – or know by heart – like the "Our Father" or the "Hail Mary." But did you know that God also wants you to use your own words when you pray? That's right! As the saints tell us, God is already waiting for you to begin a conversation with Him at any time.

When we talk to God using our own words, we call that a special type of prayer known as "meditation"! In meditation, you can say anything you want to God based on your experiences today, or based on something you read in the Bible, or something you heard at Mass. But what's also really important in meditation is making time to LISTEN to what God wants to say to you in your heart. You won't necessarily hear God meowing...errr...speaking in a loud voice, but God will often give you things in your heart like encouragement, peace and love.

But you have to be quiet to pick up on those graces God wants to give you. That can be tough sometimes. I know. I am a cat. I meow and chirp and purr so much, that I sometimes forget to be quiet and soak in the love God has for me in peace and silence. Why not take a few minutes today and do meditation: tell God, in your own words, both a joy and a struggle that you are

experiencing and then be quiet for a little while and listen for what God is trying to say to your heart!

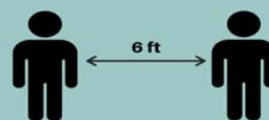
