LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

In this second week of November, I have a "mixed bag" of things to share with you.

First of all, congratulations to the newly ordained deacons of the Diocese of Columbus, especially to St. Andrews' own Deacon Victor Nduaguba and Deacon Dan Dowler, who were ordained to the diaconate by Bishop Brennan on Saturday, November 7th! We wish them God's blessings upon their diaconal ministry for many years to come!

Secondly, I want to inform you that St. Andrew Parish has a temporary priest guest with us. Fr. Paul A. Noble, until recently the pastor of St. John Neumann Parish in Sunbury, has been granted a temporary medical leave by Bishop Brennan. He is residing at St. Andrew Parish during this time of healing. I know Father Noble well as we were housemates previously when I was in residence at St. Matthew Parish in Gahanna while he was the pastor there. Although Fr. Noble is not assigned to service at St. Andrew, you may see him from time to time. Suffice it to say that we are now a very full house at St. Andrew rectory, with three priests, a cat, and a dog!


I also want to say a word about our ongoing efforts to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus and COVID-19 illnesses. With the recent increase in the numbers of cases, it continues to be important that we practice social distancing, proper hand hygiene, and the wearing of masks whenever we come to church or any other gathering. The rules have not changed, and now is not the time to relax our observance of them. In recent weeks, I have noticed people gathering in the

vestibule of the church before or after Mass and socializing. Although in normal times, this would be a good thing to do in the "gathering space," it is something that really should be avoided at present. Also, now that the weather has turned colder, I want to remind you that if you plan to attend Mass in person, please dress warmly, because the church doors will remain open before, during, and after Mass. This is important for two reasons; 1) so no one has to touch a door handle to enter or exit the church, and 2) to circulate fresh air which dissipates the virus. It also continues to be imperative that anyone with symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath should stay home and not enter the church. And those in a higher-risk category continue to be strongly cautioned against risking illness by coming to church or any other larger gathering of people. The obligation of attending Sunday Mass continues to be dispensed by the Bishops of Ohio to encourage Catholics to be cautious about coming to Mass "in person." The danger is still present and is increasing, so please make your decisions carefully!

Finally, I believe our new live streaming camera will be up and running soon. It has been installed, but we still need to learn how to operate it. But soon, our "virtual" Mass experience will be greatly enhanced.

That's all the news for now. May God bless you all throughout this week.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

Children's Liturgy of the Word 2020

COVID-19 has taken away so many things this year, including Children's Liturgy during Mass. We would still like to share with the children of St. Andrew Jesus' Word through the Gospels. Beginning today, each week we'll share some thoughts about the day's Gospel and give a question or challenge for the week. Also, be sure to read Thoughts for our Parish Children to hear about Jesus with Fr. Ferguson's cat, Jackie. - Blessings from the CLOW team

This week's Gospel: Matthew 25: 1-13

Be patient. Just wait. This year, we've waited a lot. We've waited for our favorite restaurant to reopen, our sports seasons to begin, our school to open, and our vacation to happen. The women in today's Gospel were waiting for a bridegroom. When he arrived, there would be a great feast. Christians today are also waiting for Jesus to come again. Just like in the parable, we don't know for sure when Jesus will arrive.

So what does Jesus tell us to do while we're waiting? He tells us to prepare. For example, if you were going to play baseball this spring and summer but were waiting to see if and when the season would start, you could prepare for the game. You could practice hitting, throwing, running, catching. If you were waiting for school to reopen in the fall, you could get your supplies, upgrade your Internet, get workbooks to practice.

What does Jesus want us to do to prepare for His return? We can read the Bible including the readings for each day. We can pray anytime, anywhere. We can follow the Commandments, especially the Great Commandment.

Jesus is coming and we don't know when. We don't want to be like the foolish women and miss out on the great feast of the Kingdom of God with Jesus. Your challenge this week: Do something that will prepare you for Jesus' return.





