LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

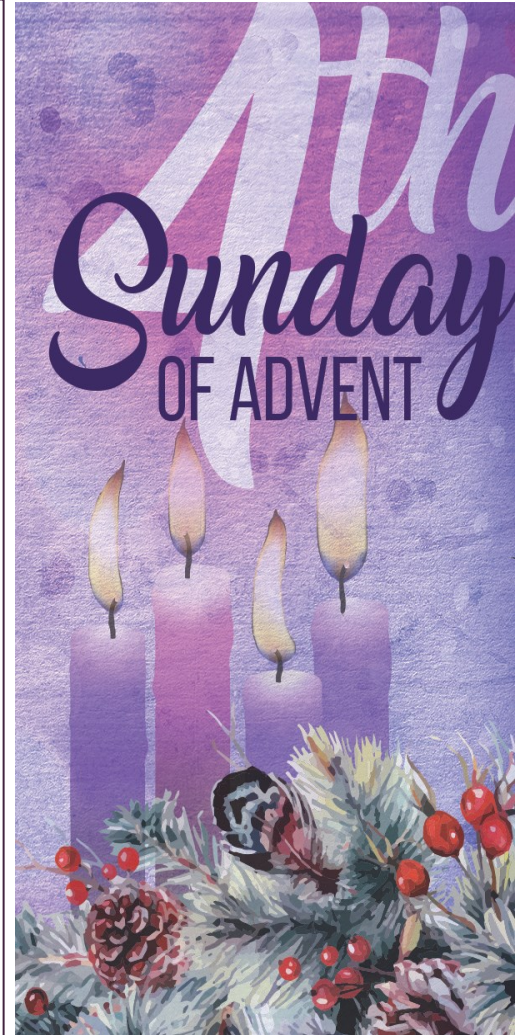
Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent, which means that Christmas, the feast of Christ's birth, is just a few days away. The Lord is indeed very near to us, and that is something we must remember and hold on to in faith in these difficult times.

Christmas, the celebration of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, is not just another day in the church's calendar. In fact, this feast is of such great importance that the Church celebrates it for a whole week, which we call the "Octave" of Christmas. "Octave" refers to the eight days that make up the week-long celebration. In a special way this year, the unforgettable Year of the Pandemic, I am encouraging all of you to celebrate Christmas throughout the entire Octave, especially if you are unable or are choosing not to attend Christmas Mass in person due to the danger of the virus or for any other reason. Since each day in the Octave is a continuation of the celebration of Christmas, you may decide to attend Mass in person on one of those days rather than on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. We are also planning to celebrate Vespers, or Evening Prayer, on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday after Christmas. This simple service of song and prayer will take place at 6:00 p.m. on those days in the church. I am hoping that at least a small group will come to church in-person to join in these services, and they will also be livestreamed so that those at home can join in the prayers as well. The texts are included in the Christmas worship aid booklet that has been prepared to enhance our participation in all of the liturgies of the Christmas Octave, whether in person at Church or safe at home via livestream. There is more information about using this booklet (which will also be available online) elsewhere in today's bulletin.

I would also like to thank all who made their reservations for attending Christmas Masses in person at St. Andrew. I appreciate your cooperation. Please remember to bring your reservation confirmation to Church when you come as it must be presented for admission. I am sorry that we have to limit attendance in this way, but we are obliged to enforce social distancing by limiting the number of persons in the church. Again, thank you for your cooperation.

We are certainly celebrating Christmas very differently this year, but I do wish all of you the peace and hope of Christ, the comfort and joy of the Holy Spirit, and a very Merry Christmas!

December 20, 2020

Today is the fourth Sunday of Advent. We light the last purple candle of the Advent Wreath. Our waiting is almost over.

The Gospel for today is called The Annunciation, which means the announcement of Jesus' coming birth. This means that a savior is really going to be born for us. Our waiting is over and our hope is finally coming true!

The Angel Gabriel appears to Mary and tells her that she will be the mother of our savior. The angel says "Do not be afraid..." but I think she was probably a little afraid." But Mary said, "I am the Lord's servant, may it happen to me as you said." Mary said "yes" to God.

I wonder how many of us always have the courage to say "yes" to God, especially at those times when we are tempted to do something that we know is wrong or when we know something will be very hard for us?

Mary not only said "yes" to God. She praised and thanked God for choosing her to do something that was not going to be very easy. Mary had a lot of courage and faith that God would be with her during hard times. Her prayer of praise and thanksgiving is called The Magnificat.

Let's think about that and try to remember that God is always with us, especially in the hard times. Let's try to thank God every day this coming week for all that God does for us.
