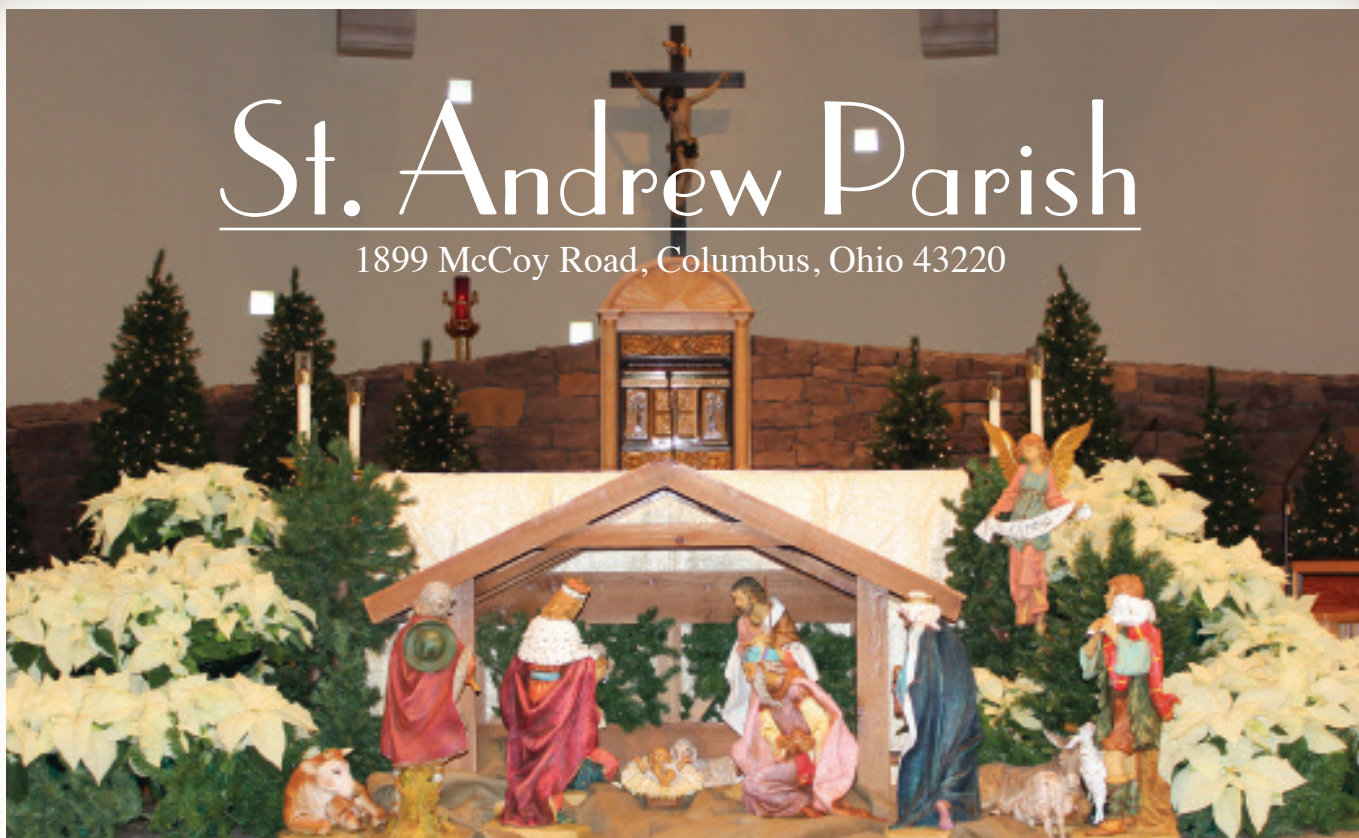

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

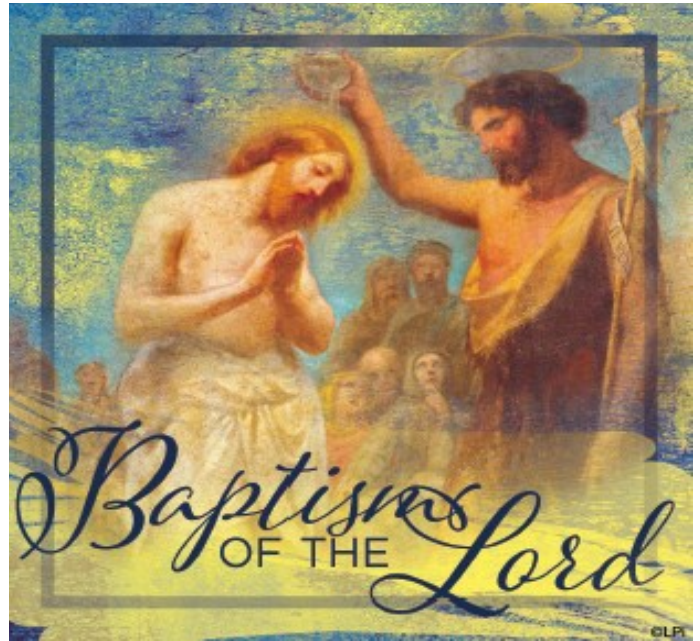
Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which marks the end of the Christmas season according to the Church's liturgical calendar. Monday begins the season of Ordinary Time, which will continue until Ash Wednesday. As the season of Christmas closes, I would like to reflect on our experience of Christmas 2020 here at St. Andrew Parish in this most unusual year. First of all, I want to thank all who helped plan, prepare, and execute our liturgical celebrations for Christmas and the Octave. I am especially grateful to the members of the Liturgy Committee who set up the reservation system we used to control the "in person" attendance at our Christmas Masses and ensure that they would not be overcrowded. The system worked well, and our ushers and other volunteers helped those attending find their seats. Because of the snow, cold temperatures and hazardous driving conditions, attendance on Christmas Eve was less than expected. Using our new livestream camera system, we were able to livestream all of our Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses, as well as daily Masses and Vespers (Evening Prayer) during the Octave. I was pleased with the Vespers services, and although attendance was small, those who attended appreciated this peaceful and prayerful experience. There were a number of people who joined in Vespers via livestream also. I want to thank those who helped operate the livestream camera so as to bring our liturgies to those who are staying home. This has become a very important way for St. Andrew parishioners to stay connected to their parish in these times in which it is necessary for many to avoid coming to church in person. I have also learned how to operate the livestream camera and got some practice doing so during the Christmas Octave!

Another success was the worship aid booklet that we used for all the Masses and Vespers of the Christmas Octave. This booklet helped us all to participate fully in these celebrations, whether in person or via livestream. Many thanks to Phil Lortz for his hard work on this and for providing music for all the Masses and services throughout the Christmas Octave. A huge Thank-You goes to the volunteers who decorated the church so beautifully for Christmas, and to our maintenance staff for all the preparation, setup, constant disinfecting and sanitizing, and snow removal.

Finally, let me thank you parishioners for your continuing support for St. Andrew Parish, for your peaceful and uncomplaining compliance with all the safety protocols and for your calm perseverance through this long ordeal. I thank you also for your expressions of support and concern for me and the clergy of St. Andrew, and for your encouraging Christmas greetings, cards, messages, gifts, goodies and other tokens of Christmas cheer. Thank you so much! May God bless you all and keep you safe!

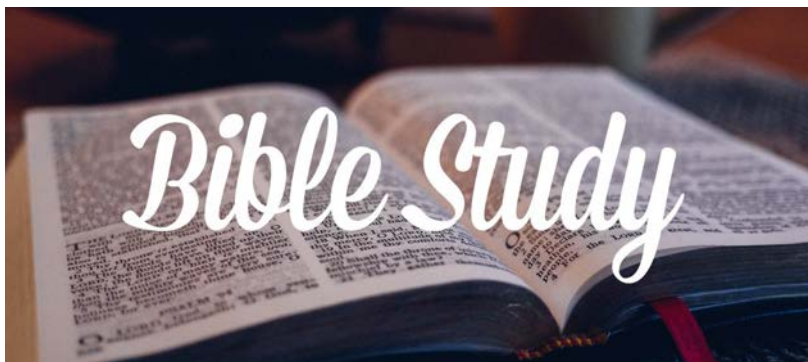

Today's Gospel:
Mark 1: 7-11

Today is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. John the Baptist began baptizing people in the Jordan River. Jesus came to the river to be baptized by John and officially begin His ministry. Something very special happened. The Holy Spirit came down like a dove and God the Father spoke. "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

We receive the Sacrament of Baptism, just like Jesus. At our Baptism we are anointed with special oils. Holy water is poured over our head. The Holy Spirit comes down and remains with us. God says, "You are my beloved son/daughter; with you I am well pleased." We also receive the Light of Christ with the baptismal candle. Baptism is a very special sacrament where we become children of God.

You probably don't remember your Baptism. Most of us are baptized as babies. Maybe you've seen a brother, sister, or cousin Baptized. But there are special people in your life who do remember your Baptism. Ask your parents, older siblings, grandparents, or godparents to share stories and pictures. Have them show you your Baptism candle or special outfit. Take some time today to remember the special day when you were Baptized and became a member of God's church.

FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

St. Andrew Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2020 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

During the 2020 Fiscal Year (October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020), **19** full members and **13** associate members of St. Andrew's Society of St. Vincent de Paul participated in activities to serve those in need. Members responded to **77** requests for assistance and assisted **187** individuals and family members. **Twenty-one** home visits/telephone consultations were made to people living in our parish area. Parishioner's monetary and "in kind" donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest parts of the diocese.

Works of Mercy
