

CHILDREN'S LITURGY
Today's Gospel: John 1:35-42

In today's Gospel we see John the Baptist with his disciples. When Jesus walks by, John points to Him and says, "Behold, the Lamb of God." Two disciples chose to leave John and begin following Jesus. One of those disciples was St. Andrew, the namesake of our church. St. Andrew also told his brother, Simon about Jesus. Simon became St. Peter, our first Pope.

Who points you toward Jesus? Your parents bring you to church and teach you about Jesus. They also pray with you. Your teachers at school or PSR share stories about Jesus and teach you how to follow Him. Msgr. Moloney, Fr. Ferguson, Fr. DeVille, and our parish deacons also work hard in our church. 
The past year has been exceptionally challenging, marked by illness, economic hardship, and tension. For many, it has meant isolation from each other and from the support found within our parish community.

The OSU \$25,000 Annual Ronald C. Sullivan Scholarship is available through The Catholic Foundation on February 1st - March 29th

Ronald C. Sullivan was a man of faith, education, business, and duty. He considered his Catholicism the foundation of his identity and as a lifelong Buckeye of The Ohio State University, Sullivan saw a college education as a key to success. His education led him to become a successful businessman and investor, where he started an insurance brokerage firm that he sold at the young age of 55. He later became a day trader using the public library as his office and also served in the U.S. Army in Germany.

Requirements for the Ronald C. Sullivan Scholarship are as follows:

Student must be a current high school senior enrolled or about to enroll at The Ohio State University, a practicing Catholic (as verified by a letter from a parish leader such as a priest, deacon, or youth minister), active member of St. Andrew, St. Agatha, Our Lady of Victory or St. Christopher. Or must be an active Catholic living within Upper Arlington, Grandview Heights, or Marble Cliff. Student must have a solid academic performance.

St. Charles Annual 8th Grade Scholarship Test and Private Family Visits

St. Charles Preparatory School is offering its annual 8th Grade Scholarship Test for prospective students on **January 30, 2021**. Students may take the test at either 9 a.m. or 1 p.m. in the school's Robert C. Walter Student Commons. Online registration is required. The exam is open to any 8th grade boy regardless of his current high school enrollment status. This is not an entrance exam. Test results determine which students will receive merit-based academic awards from the school for the 2021-2022 school year. For this 2020-2021 school year alone, St. Charles has offered more than \$400,000 in academic scholarships and grants to its students.
