MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

The holy season of Lent has begun! The word "Lent" comes from an old word that means "Spring." With the temperature about 11 degrees as I am writing this, and thick, white snow covering the ground, I think I am ready for Spring! Lent is a season of growth. Just as seeds are planted in the Spring and begin to grow and take root, so we hope that the Word of God will grow in us. In this season of Lent, we plant the seeds of holiness. We do this through our repentance, our turning away from sin, and turning toward the gospel. We do this through our acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In these various ways, we not only plant the seeds of holiness, but we nurture them and cultivate them as well. I especially recommend to you this Lent that you consider attending daily Mass if it is safe for you to do so, praying Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings at St. Andrew Church, and participating in Eucharistic Adoration. We have Eucharistic Adoration every Tuesday beginning at 6 p.m., and ending with Compline and Benediction at 8:45 p.m. Also, don't forget the "40 Days of Adoration" already taking place throughout the diocese during the season of Lent. Adoration is held in a different parish of the diocese each day. St. Andrew Parish will host this on Tuesday, March 23. These are just a few ideas for making Lent a season of spiritual growth.

Next Sunday, February 28, Bishop Brennan will be here at St. Andrew to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at 3 p.m. Our celebration will be much different this year because of the COVID-19 precautions. Last year, we had our Confirmation just before everything shut down. I never would have thought that a year later we would still be dealing with the coronavirus pandemic! I want to thank the confirmation candidates for their letters to me explaining why they desire to be confirmed. I am always inspired by the zeal of our young people.

I wish all of you a blessed and holy first week of Lent!

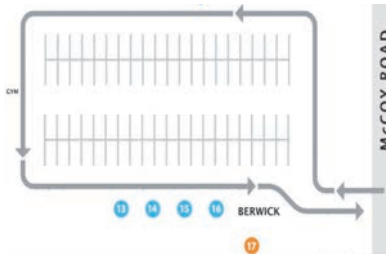

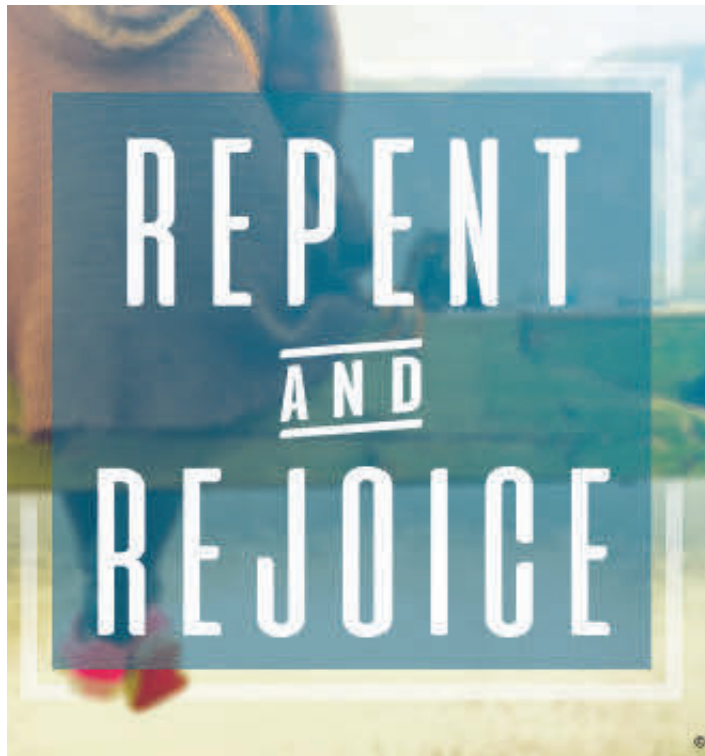

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

Today's Gospel Mark 1:12-15

Today is the first Sunday of Lent. Lent is a season of preparation. We'll spend the next 40 days preparing for Jesus' death and Resurrection. This is a time where we give things up and do good works. WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Q: Does it matter which leg you kneel on when genuflecting?



A. Genuflection is an act of devotion that literally means "to bend the knee." For many Catholics, it's an almost automatic gesture that we perform before entering our pew or row of seats at Mass. But, like many of the symbols and gestures of our faith tradition, genuflecting can also be an invitation for deeper reflection. The practice of "bending the knee" is an ancient way of recognizing the presence of someone greater than we are. It has been said that the practice dates back to the time of Alexander the Great, but it became a common part of etiquette in the royal courts of the Middle Ages. From throne rooms and palaces, it was a small step to genuflecting, becoming part of the devotional lives of Christians who used this secular gesture as a way of recognizing the presence of the One who is King of Kings, especially in the Eucharist. In our tradition, although many have been taught or prefer to genuflect by placing their right knee on the ground, there is no prescribed way to genuflect. This is especially important to keep in mind if physical limitations or age make certain movements difficult for us.

Today, Catholics are asked to genuflect in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (whether in the tabernacle or exposed on the altar during Eucharistic Adoration). So, while it has become second nature to genuflect before entering your seat in church, we should pay attention to where the Blessed Sacrament is kept in each church or chapel we visit, and genuflect in the direction of the tabernacle where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. In churches or chapels in which the tabernacle is in a separate space, we are invited to simply bow toward the altar.



LIVE THE LITURGY WEEKLY INSPIRATION

Throughout history, God has given His people signs. Our season of Lent offers us God's sign that it is time to stop the ordinary routines of our lives, create some desert space, and listen more attentively for God to reveal His presence. We are asked to unplug from our attachments, compulsions, obsessions, addictions, routines, and busyness to clear the slate and take stock in who we have become. We are asked to remember the ancient sign of God's covenant with humanity in which He vowed to nurture, sustain, and protect the relationship He has with His people. Once we slow down a bit and clear away some of the clutter, we can see how the journey of our life is unfolding. We can see what brings us in and out of tune with God's love and how we can better imitate God's loving fidelity in our relationship with Him. Even though some good solid self-denial is the order of the day, greater happiness and wholeness will be the fruit of our labors. Pleasant journey through the desert!
