## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I want to bring the following important matters to your attention:

1. **The Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** is a short survey conducted by the Catholic Leadership Institute that asks you to reflect on your spiritual growth and provide input that will help us evaluate how the parish helps you grow and how we can do better. This is a very important part of the Diocese of Columbus' strategic planning process and I am hoping for the highest possible survey response from our parishioners. The survey is available at [www.catholicleaders.org/columbusdmi](http://www.catholicleaders.org/columbusdmi). Paper surveys are also available in the vestibule and at the entrances of the church. The survey will remain active through March 21.

2. **This weekend, Bishop Brennan is launching "Real Presence, Real Future," an ongoing diocesan-wide campaign to promote missionary, discipleship, and effective evangelization.** You'll find a detailed insert in today's bulletin and we will be uploading a video message from the Bishop to our YouTube channel at [www.StAndrewParishLive.com](http://www.StAndrewParishLive.com). DMI (mentioned above) is a part of this program. Collectively, we the faithful people of the Diocese of Columbus, are being called to engage in a prayerful and thoughtful process to chart the future and determine how the Churches in our diocese will make Christ present and draw people to Him. I am counting on your participation in all the aspects of this campaign.

3. **"40 Days of Adoration" continues throughout the season of Lent** in the Diocese to emphasize the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and to remind us that Christ is truly always present in and through the Church. St. Andrew will host this solemn Adoration from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on March 23. Please use the link found at the back of the bulletin to commit to an hour to spend with Our Lord.

4. **We would like your input as we prepare for Easter celebrations.** Like Christmas, we are surveying parishioners to see how many people we should prepare to welcome for Easter Masses and determine if we need to use a reservation system again. If you haven't responded already, please let us know your Easter Mass plans by either completing the survey in this bulletin or the online survey at [www.standrewparish.cc/about-us/easter-mass-survey/](http://www.standrewparish.cc/about-us/easter-mass-survey/).

Finally, congratulations to our young people who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this Sunday! We are very proud of you. May the gifts of the Holy Spirit remain with you your whole life long!

May God bless you all and help you grow in holiness during these days of Lent.

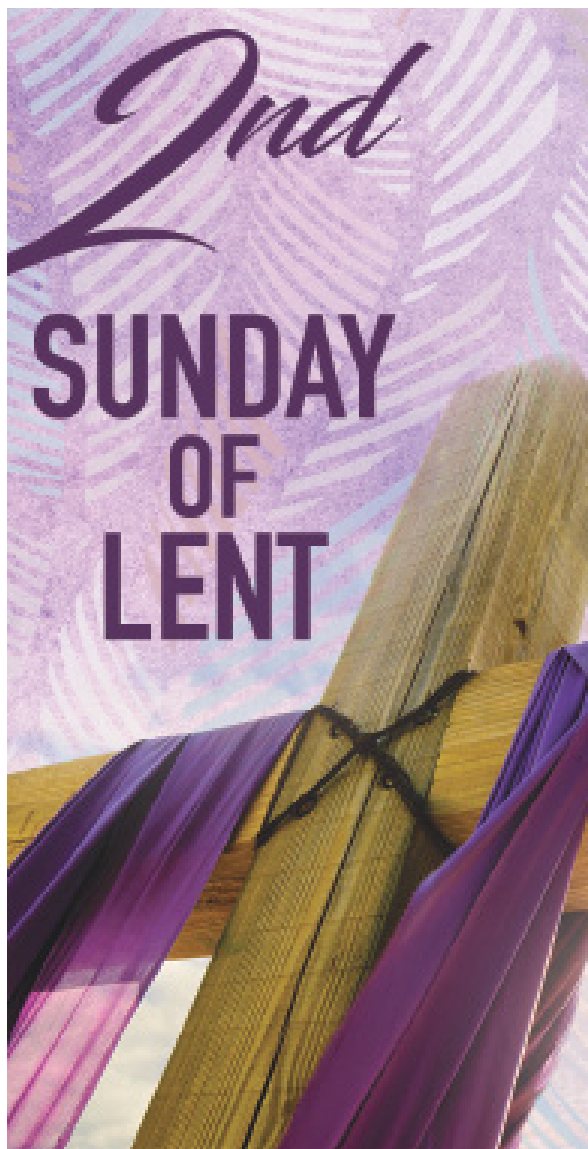

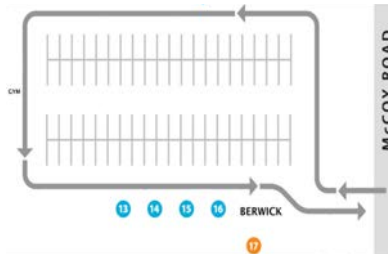

## CHILDREN'S LITURGY

### Today's Gospel Mark 9: 2-10

When special things happen in our lives, we want to record them. We may take pictures or videos to help us remember the important event. In today's Gospel, something special happens to Jesus. He is transfigured. He changes and shines, dazzling white. Moses and Elijah appear and join Him on the mountain. Then they talk to each other. Peter, James, and John were with them and they realize this is a special event. Peter asks to make three tents for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah. The Apostles want to remember this. After Jesus died and rose from the dead, the Transfiguration was shared and written down in the Gospels.

Just like we may keep pictures to remember, people in the past wrote down special stories in the Bible. The writers of the Bible were inspired by the Holy Spirit. The New Testament tells us about Jesus' life and the beginning of the Church. The Old Testament tells us about God's connection to humans throughout time. All the stories are special events for us to read and remember. God wants us to learn about Him by reading the Bible. He also wants us to share the Good News with others. This week, read a story in the Bible and share the story with someone else.

## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! I'm sorry that I missed you last week and did not write anything to you. I took a nap and slept for several days, and Father Ferguson could not wake me up. I felt bad about it when I woke up, because as followers of Jesus during this Season of Lent, we should be awake and alert and ready to fight against evil and sin at any moment!



I suppose it would help to be a wide-awake "soldier of Christ" against evil if I had a special Sacrament that a lot of the big kids in our parish are going to be receiving later today: the Sacrament of Confirmation! That's right! Did you know that today, 80 of our big kids in Grade 8 here at St. Andrew are going to receive a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit when our Bishop (that's our local Catholic leader!) comes to offer them Confirmation? The Bishop will put special holy oil on their heads, and the Holy Spirit will invisibly come to them to make them even stronger to be holy (it's often tougher to be holy when you're a teenager!). And, the Holy Spirit will also help them share our great Faith with their friends who don't yet know about Jesus. It's just like what happened to the 12 Apostles at Pentecost! Isn't that amazing? Father Ferguson told me I should be on my best behavior at today's Confirmation Mass. The Holy Spirit is often depicted as a dove - a special kind of bird - and Father told me that **under no circumstances** should I pounce on the dove of the Holy Spirit and eat it for a snack! He said that would not make Jesus very happy.

So today, I'm going to be nice and put my paws into a prayer posture and I'm going to pray really hard that our big kids of Grade 8 have a powerful experience of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation, and that they stay strong and holy as they get older as teenagers. Why not take a few minutes today and pray for them, too! Have a "purr"-fect week!
