Dear Parishioners,

I was recently making a phone call to the cable company and was placed "on hold" for some time. During this time, I began to reflect on the experience of being "on hold." Being "on hold" is a time of idle waiting during which nothing happens until someone is connected, and they ask, "how can I help you?" Then, you are no longer "on hold." I began to think about how our lives seem to have been "on hold" for many months now because of the Coronavirus pandemic. We have been waiting and waiting for it to be over, for our lives to go back to "normal," but we are still waiting, and here it is now almost a year later. It's as if we were placed "on hold" last March, and we are still waiting.

But as I thought about it some more, I realized that, unlike being "on hold" while waiting for a customer service representative to take a phone call, many things have happened and continue to happen during these months when it seemed and seems that life itself is "on hold." The life of our parish goes on differently, of course, but it continues. Babies are baptized, weddings are celebrated, Confessions are heard, the sick are anointed, the dying are given last rites, the deceased are given funeral rites, families are comforted, the Word of God is preached, children and adults are prepared to receive the sacraments. I also want to assure you that the priests of St. Andrew Parish are ready to serve you. If you or a member of your family are experiencing any pastoral or sacramental need requiring the services of a priest, please contact me and let me know. I will respond as quickly as I can, and I won't keep you "on hold" indefinitely! Meanwhile, keep your spirits up. Look forward to a better day. Remember, we are all in this together!

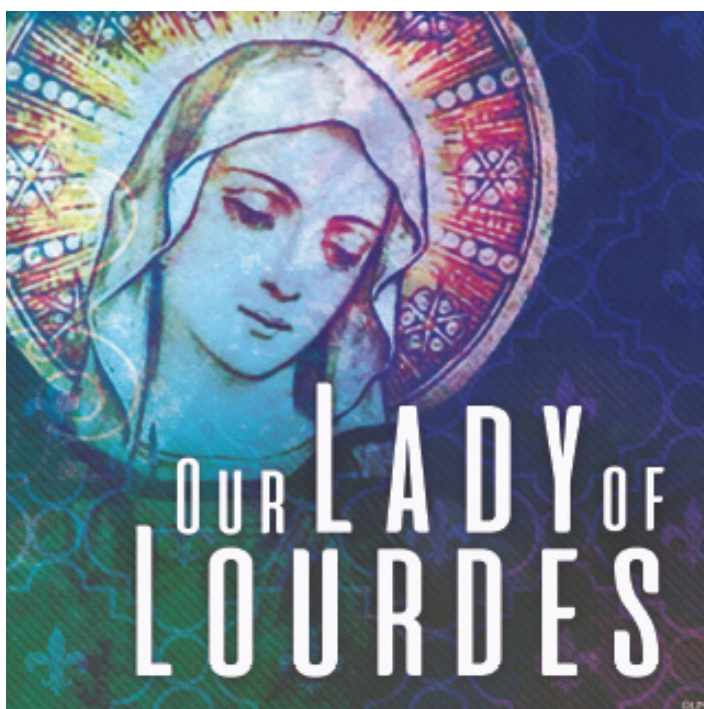

Today's Gospel Mark 1: 29-39

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! This week is going to be a special one for many of you. On Wednesday, those of you in Grade 2 are going to be experiencing the Sacrament of Confession for the very first time! That's right! Confession, also known as Reconciliation, is when you get to come to Jesus and ask Him for help and forgiveness for the things we do that keep us from being as holy as we're meant to be. God made us to be holy just like Him, but as we all know, it can be really tough always to do what is good and right. We often face temptations, or urges to do bad things....what we call "sins." Jesus never sinned, but He knows what it feels like to be tempted.

So, when you come to talk to Jesus in Confession (with the help of a priest), Jesus is going to be very kind to you to help you to be cleaned from those sins, and to do better in the future. Father Ferguson often tells kids that going to Confession is not like going to the Principal's Office in fear to be punished for doing something wrong, but it's more like going to a Doctor's Office with a sense of relief, to be fully healed from the sins that make our souls sick and sad. Don't ever be afraid to come to Confession. Jesus knows how easy it can be to be tempted; the Bible tells us that Satan even tried tempting Jesus many times....but never succeeded. And as a cat, I know how tempting it is to do bad things, too....like growling at Father when he wants me to get out of his chair; or poking fun at Mabel the dog and hiding her toys; or taunting the birds outside my window....It's tough to stay holy!



Jesus is your friend who wants to help you to be healed and made stronger in Confession. So, let's all pray for those in Grade 2 this week who will be experiencing their First Confession! Have a "purr"-fect week!



WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Q: Is it ever ok to leave Mass before it ends?

A: This is an interesting question, because beneath the surface, there seems to be an assumption that if it's okay, then why do we have to stay after we receive Communion? The short answer is "no," but we definitely want to go a bit deeper as we consider why.

If we simply leave after we receive Communion, we risk two things. First, there is the possibility that we will turn our reception of Communion into a purely personal, individual experience that is separated from our common experience of worship — and Communion in the fullest sense — and, second, we lose an opportunity for gratitude and serious reflection if we simply leave after Communion. This time of thanksgiving, reflection, and, ultimately, missioning, are important and, in the end, an essential part of the celebration of the Mass.
