We exist to fulfill the mission of the Roman Catholic Church at the local level by continuing the saving work of Christ. We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Today we begin Holy Week in which we celebrate the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ. On Palm Sunday, we commemorate Jesus' solemn entrance into the holy city of Jerusalem. Although He is greeted with shouts of "Hosanna to the Son of David," the royal welcome turns quickly to cries of "Crucify him!" This year on Palm Sunday, we will hear the Passion according to Mark. Because we do not have missals available in the pews, we will be proclaiming the Passion differently than in the past, which will not involve the congregation speaking any parts.

I remind you of the opportunities for Confession this week on **Monday ("Reconciliation Monday") from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m.** and continuing thereafter until all are heard. On **Wednesday, Confessions will take place from 7:00 p.m. until all are heard.** Confessions take place in the church. On **Good Friday, Confessions will be heard following the Good Friday Liturgy and following Stations of the Cross until all are heard.**

On Tuesday of this week, the priests and deacons will be attending the Chrism Mass celebrated by Bishop Brennan. At this Mass, the priests renew their commitment to the priesthood, and the holy oils used to celebrate the sacraments throughout the year are blessed by the Bishop. I am very happy that we are celebrating all the ceremonies of the Sacred Paschal Triduum this year, unlike last year. Although the ceremonies will be slightly modified because of COVID-19 safety protocols, we will still be able to gather for these solemn and meaningful celebrations. Of course, we must wear masks, keep our distance as best we can, and sanitize our hands frequently, but we can celebrate these liturgies together. At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on the evening of Holy Thursday, we will omit the "Mandatum" (the washing of feet); there will be Holy Communion for the faithful under the form of bread only (not from the cup except for the priests), and the Altar of Repose will be in the main church rather than the chapel.

**On Good Friday, the Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord will take place at 3:00 p.m.** The Passion according to John will be proclaimed in a different way than we are accustomed to because there are no missals. The Veneration of the Cross will not include the people coming forward to kiss the cross individually.

## **Monsignor's Message continued**

The Easter Vigil which begins Saturday, April 2, 8:30 p.m., and includes the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for our RCIA Elect and Candidates, will be slightly simplified. We won't use congregational candles nor gather outside for the lighting of the Easter fire. We won't fill the baptismal font or the holy water stoops, but we will include the renewal of baptismal promises and sprinkling with Holy Water. It will be good to have the refreshing blessing of Holy Water after such a long drought! Easter Sunday Masses will also include the renewal of baptismal promises and the sprinkling with Holy Water. Easter Sunday may be crowded, and social distancing may be somewhat difficult. If attending in person, masks are a MUST. Although the dispensation from the Sunday obligation is still in effect, I do expect a larger attendance on Easter, so please be prepared for this and be very careful when coming to Mass. I do plan to have all of the Masses and services of the Triduum and Easter livestreamed for those who will not be attending in person.

This Holy Week, let us acclaim Christ our Savior saying, "We adore you O Christ and we praise you because, by your holy Cross, you have redeemed the world!"

## LIVE THE LITURGY

### Inspiration for the Week

What an ironic twist of events! Jesus is hailed with palm branches as He comes down a street one minute and faces agonizing suffering and death on a cross the next. Does any of this make any sense? They shouted, “hosanna to our King,” out of one side of their mouths and, “crucify him,” out of the other. At first glance it seems like such hypocrisy. Yet, when we step back, there may be more truth to the story than we care to admit. We struggle with Jesus. We hail Him in our churches, but struggle to figure out what to do with Him on our streets.

We are fine when we hear pious renderings of His messages and preaching, but wince when it gets to the part about changing the way we conduct business and becoming more sensitive to the disadvantaged, poor and marginalized. We invoke God’s name when we want victory and keep silence when it comes to global solidarity. We talk out of both sides of our mouths, too, looking only to what works or suits us at the time and leaving the rest. There exists in each one of us a person who hails our King with hosannas and a person who is all too willing to choose Jesus over Barabbas for the cross. Something to think about this Holy Week!

## Palm Sunday



People of Jerusalem welcome Jesus as king as he triumphantly enters the city



Crowd waves palms and lays cloaks on the ground before him



Jesus rides in on a donkey to fulfill Old Testament prophecies



The liturgy begins with blessing of palms, an extra reading about Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, and a procession while the congregation waves palms to play the part of the crowds



Take the palms and place them in your home or workplace as a witness to faith in Jesus' Paschal Victory

Put yourself in the shoes of the people who first welcomed Christ as king, but in a matter of days, called for his crucifixion

Though chronologically three days, the **PASCHAL TRIDUUM** is one liturgical day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery

## Holy Thursday



Jesus celebrates the Last Supper with his Apostles



Jesus institutes the Eucharist and constitutes the Apostles as priests



Displaying great humility, Jesus washes the feet of his Apostles



Gives *mandatum*, command to love one another as he has loved them



During the agony in the garden, he accepts God's will, then is arrested



Make a pilgrimage to visit seven churches in your area

Spend an hour in adoration

At the end of Mass the altar is stripped and all decorations are covered or removed. Even the tabernacle is emptied and all consecrated hosts are moved to an Altar of Repose to mimic the absence and loss felt by the disciples during Jesus' agony and death.

No final blessing as the liturgical day continues

While Jesus was being questioned, Peter denies him three times



Pilate has Jesus scourged and a crown of thorns put on his head



Jesus carries his own cross to Calvary, where he is crucified



With the words, "It is finished," Jesus dies and darkness descends



Jesus is taken down from the cross and placed in the tomb



Fasting and abstinence from meat

Pray the Stations of the Cross

Maintain silence during the hours Jesus was on the cross

## Easter Sunday



Jesus rises, conquering death, and opening the path to new life!



Empty tomb is found first by the holy women, then by Peter and John



Jesus appears to multiple groups of disciples, they see and believe



Take part in a festive gathering with family and friends to honor this day as the highest of feasts



Catechumens receive sacraments of initiation, and the whole congregation renews baptismal vows

We sing Alleluia again for the first time since the beginning of Lent

The new Paschal candle is carried into the church and the congregations' candles are lit from it

Start by blessing the table and home with holy water from the Easter Mass

Keep the celebration going during the Octave of Easter for eight days, and the Easter season for 50 days until Pentecost
