## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter! I know, I already wished all of you a Happy Easter last Sunday, but today, the Octave of Easter is still Easter! Our Holy Week and Easter liturgies were beautiful and inspiring, and I thank all of those who helped to make them so, especially our musicians, cantors, and those who decorated the church. I was very happy to see a number of parishioners returning to "in person" Mass for the first time after many months of cautiously staying home to keep safe from the spread of COVID. The vaccination has been very liberating for those who have received it. I hope that those who have not yet been vaccinated will do so soon, so we can all gather safely together for Mass again.

## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Dear Parish Children:



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Did you know that today, we are still celebrating Easter? That's right! We Catholics love celebrating things, and Jesus' Resurrection from the dead is one of the biggest things we can ever get excited about! That's why this whole past week, from last Sunday until today, has been one long celebration of Easter Day! That's why this past week has been called the "Easter Octave"! And today is the final day of the Easter Octave!

And today is a special day for another reason, too. Today, the Sunday after Easter Sunday, is always known as "Divine Mercy Sunday"! The word "mercy" means when someone shows patience and forgiveness to you instead of being too hard on you for your sins. And that's what God wants to do for all of us.... He wants to show mercy for us and help us to get to Heaven! The Resurrection of Jesus, which opens up Heaven for us, shows how merciful God is.

It's kind of like when I was a kitten, and Father Ferguson tried to be patient with me and forgive me when I was learning not to scratch his furniture or jump up onto the kitchen counter. And ever since, we Catholics have been praying the special prayer called the "Divine Mercy Chaplet." And in the last few years, this Sunday after Easter has become the special day to celebrate Divine Mercy!

Isn't it great that God is always so patient with us, and gives us second chances to get to Heaven? Why not take a few minutes today and pray to God and thank Him for all His love and patience for you! Happy Easter! And have a "purr"-fect week!

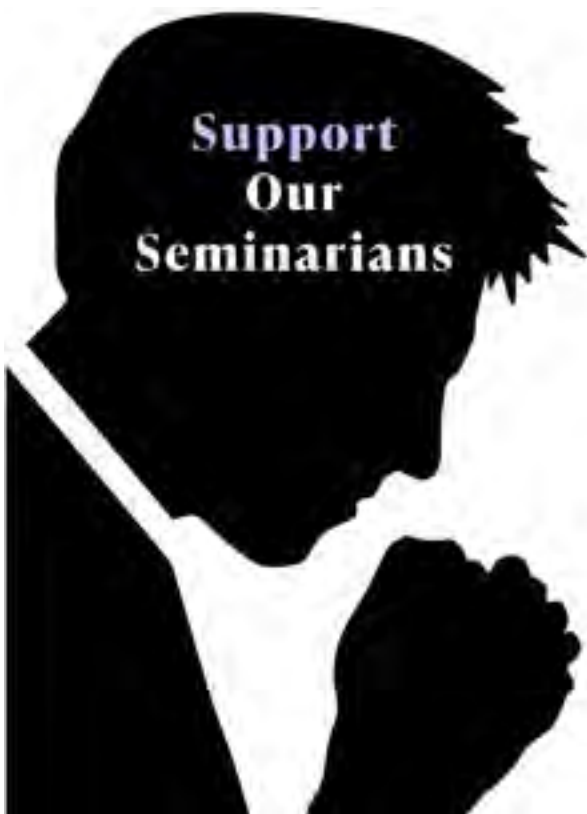

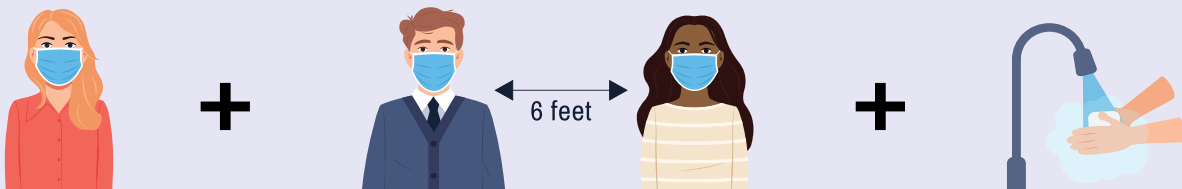
## After Your Vaccine, Continue to Mask Up



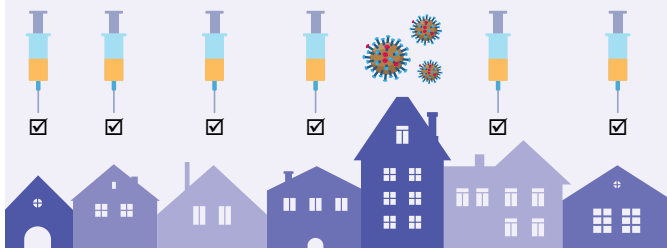
**After I receive both doses of the vaccine, will I still need to wear a mask?**

**YES.** You should still **wear a mask, practice social distancing** and **frequently wash your hands**, even if you have received the COVID-19 vaccine.

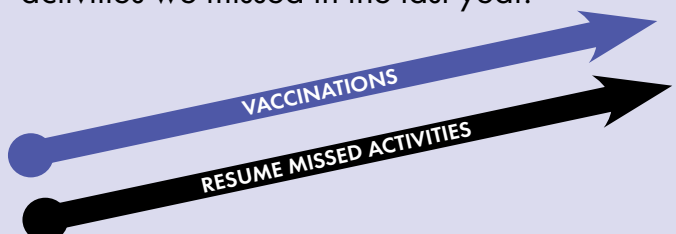
Protection from the vaccine is not perfect. It remains unknown if you can still spread the virus to other people once you have been vaccinated.



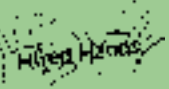
