MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I was outside with my dog Mabel the other morning, and as she sniffed and browsed in the thick green grass of the rectory lawn, I happened to remember a silly rhyme my mother used to say:

Spring has sprung
The grass is riz
I wonder where
The flowers is?

Spring has indeed sprung. After a bleak winter, trees are leafing out, redbuds and crabapple trees are blossoming, buds are appearing, and green grass is growing. All of these are signs of New Life. Birds are singing and building their nests. Tulips and daffodils have already bloomed, and soon other flowers will take their places, like the fragrant lilacs. The rebirth of the natural world in the Spring of the year is a beautiful reminder of our spiritual rebirth that we celebrate in this season of Eastertide in the Church's liturgical year. The Easter Season, which began with the Easter Vigil on April 3, lasts for 50 days, and ends on the evening of Pentecost Sunday, which falls on May 23 this year.

The Paschal Candle, which was lighted at the Easter Vigil, stands burning in the sanctuary of the church near the ambo, tall and proud, as a symbol of Christ risen from the dead. He rose victorious from the darkness of the tomb and the light of His risen glory shines on all of those He has redeemed.

Throughout the Easter season, we celebrate our own rebirth in the waters of Baptism, when we died and rose with Christ when we cast off the old life of sin and clothed ourselves as Christ and began to live a new life in Him in sincerity and truth. This Easter Season is the springtime of our souls! Just like the green grass rises from the earth, Christ has risen from the dead, and He gives New Life to our souls. Now we look for faith, hope, and love to blossom in abundance!

THE FIVE EFFECTS OF BAPTISM

We are granted justification or sanctifying grace

When we're baptised, our original sin is forgiven and, in the case of adults, personal sins.

We receive the three theological virtues

Faith, hope and charity, the gifts of the Holy Spirit and the other virtues are received.

We receive the sacramental grace

It offers the necessary help to live a Christian life. It makes us capable of believing in God, of waiting on Him and loving Him.

A sacramental character is imprinted in us

It is an indelible spiritual mark that is imprinted during Baptism. It makes us part of the Church, Body of Christ.

It makes us part of the common priesthood of the faithful

Participation is in two forms: active, through evangelization and sanctifying all temporal realities and passive, by receiving the other sacraments.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:

Question:

Do children need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before their First Communion?

Answer:

For centuries the Catholic Church has taught that a person needs to be in a state of grace (free from mortal sins) in order to worthily receive the Eucharist. To that end, Catholics should make an effort to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation any time they recognize the need for the sacrament (and in keeping with the precept of the Church that asks that we celebrate this sacrament at least once each year).

In the case of children preparing for their First Communion, the Code of Canon Law is very clear that they should also celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving the Eucharist for the first time: "It is the responsibility, in the first place, of parents and those who take the place of parents as well as of the pastor to see that children who have reached the use of reason are correctly prepared and are nourished by the divine food as early as possible, preceded by sacramental confession" (Canon 914).

While some might question the significance of the Sacrament of Reconciliation – especially in the case of children who might not fully understand the reality of sin or the meaning of the sacrament itself – a child's "First Confession" can be a wonderful time for families to reflect together on the quality of their relationships, how they put their faith into practice, and, when it is possible, to celebrate the sacrament as a family. In the end, the celebration of these two sacraments marks important moments in the spiritual journeys of children and we hope their "First Confession" and "First Communion" help instill in them a love of the sacraments of the Church.

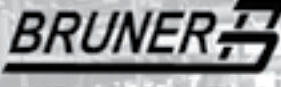

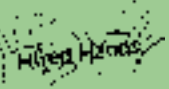
