MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Every year, St. Andrew Parish, along with all the other parishes of the Diocese of Columbus, participate in the Missionary Cooperation Plan in which a visiting missionary representing a missionary organization comes to the parish and speaks at Masses on a chosen weekend, telling us about the missionary work the organization fulfills and inviting us to support that work. A collection is taken, and St. Andrew Parish has always responded generously to these appeals.

This weekend, April 24-25, was originally to be our Mission Appeal weekend. Bishop Eusebius of the Diocese of Parassala in India was to be present and tell us about the success and challenges of the work of evangelization in his missionary diocese in India. However, earlier this year a decision was made by the Missions Office of the Diocese of Columbus (which coordinates the Missionary Cooperation Plan) to cancel "in-person" missionary appeals because of COVID precautions and to once again conduct the appeals virtually.

In the bulletin today, you will find a message from Bishop Eusebius in which he describes the needs of the missionary diocese of Parassala and asks for your support. While the continuing pandemic has prevented him from coming to us in person and sharing with us the story of his missionary work, nevertheless, the need for our support remains and is perhaps, greater than ever.

I hope that you will respond generously to this year's Mission Appeal. As I mentioned, St. Andrew parishioners have responded generously in the past, and I am confident that you will do so again. Please place your contribution envelope marked "Mission Appeal" in the designated collection baskets in church anytime over the next two weeks, mail them to the parish office, or make an electronic contribution through the Online Giving Portal – osvonlinegiving.com/4150 – and look for Mission Appeal in the dropdown menu. On behalf of Bishop Eusebius, I thank you for supporting the missionary activity of the Church.

In other news, I am happy to report that the 2020 Bishop's Annual Appeal was a success. St. Andrew Parish exceeded our goal and we recently received a refund of nearly \$8,000! Thank you for your generosity. The 2021 Appeal begins next weekend! On Sunday, April 25, St. Andrew is hosting the Miter Society Mass celebrated by Bishop Brennan.

Congratulations to our Second Grade First Communicants who will be receiving their First Holy Communion in special Masses to be celebrated on Sunday, May 1st, and Saturday, May 8th. I pray that the grace of being united with Jesus in receiving the Holy Eucharist will be theirs throughout their lives.



THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! I am pretty excited! That's right! That's because this coming Saturday, some of our second graders are going to be receiving their First Holy Communion! The Sacrament of the Eucharist is the most important part of our Catholic faith in Jesus, because, at Mass, a real miracle takes place: the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus! It's Jesus coming to be really present to us here on Earth!



One of the great things about coming to Mass and being close to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is that it's like entering a "time machine." That's right! At Mass, at the very same time, we have one paw....errr....one foot planted here in "time," and another foot planted in "eternity." That's because Jesus, the God-Man, is both human and divine! CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Council members are elected by the Parish and serve a three-year term. The Council meets the third Thursday of the month. Application forms will be available online, in upcoming bulletins and in the vestibule. The deadline to submit an application is Friday, May 14.

Dear Reverend Monsignor Stephan Moloney and the Parishioners,

Loving greetings from the Catholic Diocese of Parassala, India! I hope all of you are keeping safe and healthy during this difficult time. I am Thomas Eusebius, the first bishop of the Diocese of Parassala in India. I am very glad that I am able to reach you, dear members of the St. Andrew parish through this medium and share with you our mission realities. Your beloved bishop, Bishop Bob Brennan and I know each other since many years.

The Catholic Diocese of Parassala was established in August 2017 and is the newest diocese in the Church. It lies at the southernmost part of India. The area of the diocese is one of the most backward in the whole of South India - economically, socially and educationally. The main source of income for most people is unskilled daily labor which is not regularly and easily available. Though the children and youth in this region are intellectually gifted, they lack sufficient opportunities for primary and higher education. Hence one of the major pastoral projects of the diocese is education. Staying within our limitations as a new diocese, we are trying our best to provide educational opportunities to our children.



The diocese of Parassala is purely a mission diocese, in the sense that all the faithful of the diocese embraced the Catholic faith in the past couple of decades from other religions as the result of the effective work of evangelization by many committed priests, sisters and lay faithful. Most of our Faithful came from the backward castes of the Hindu religion, which forms almost 82% of the Indian population. As per the Indian legal system, the people belonging to the backward castes, when they are Hindus, receive many reservations and benefits from the Government in terms of jobs and educational opportunities. But as they become Catholics, they lose them. Though we have been fighting a legal battle against this injustice, we have not been successful so far. So it is the responsibility of the Church to do all that is required to promote these people and to bring them to the mainstream of the society.

The diocese of Parassala has presently 103 parishes/mission stations and only 30 incardinated priests. We were not been able to concentrate on the promotion of vocations in this area as we had many other pressing missionary needs before us. In this part of the State priests still function as the main agents of social change.

Therefore, one of the most urgent needs of the diocese is to promote vocations to priesthood and religious life which will in turn contribute to the overall development of the region. Moreover, this region provides great scope for the promotion of vocations. If proper attention is given to this field, we are sure, the diocese of Parassala will be able to provide priests and religious to other needy dioceses in the future. By the grace of God, we do not run short of candidates to priesthood, but due to the lack of resources, we are not able to accommodate all the applicants. The diocese has to meet all their expenses during their formation, as their families are not in a position to do it. We admitted the first batch of seminary students in 2018 and presently we have 36 students undergoing formation for this diocese. We require around \$ 100 per month to meet the expenses of a single seminarian. The training lasts for around 10 years. The return of the mission preaching shall be used for supporting the formation of our candidates for priesthood. Your generous support is deeply appreciated.

I thank you for your interest in our mission and I pray that the good Lord continue to bless all of you, your families and your beloved parish.
