MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday is the great feast of the Ascension of the Lord. We profess in the Creed our belief that Jesus not only suffered death and was buried and rose again on the third day, but also that "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." When Jesus ascended to Heaven and took His place at the Father's right hand, He took our humanity with Him. He came down from heaven in order to unite His divinity to our humanity in the mystery of the Incarnation.

"He came down from heaven and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." When He rose again from the dead, He rose in His human body, in the flesh, albeit glorified. And when He ascended into heaven, He ascended in His humanity, forever united to His divinity. He did not shed His humanity like a soiled garment, but rather He ascended into heaven as true God and true man. He shows us that when we shall rise again in the resurrection to new life, we will rise as whole integral human beings, body and soul.

The Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ establishes the pattern for our own heavenly and eternal destiny, and gives us cause to declare, "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." Amen! The feast of the Ascension is also the prelude to Pentecost. Jesus promised His disciples that once He ascended to the Father, He would send the Paraclete, the Advocate, namely, the Holy Spirit. In the days between the Ascension and Pentecost, the church traditionally prays for an outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, that the Church may be sanctified and empowered to proclaim the Gospel of Christ and give witness to Him. Let us pray during this coming week that we may all be renewed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit, that each of us may build up the Body of Christ, the Church.

May the Holy Spirit be with you all!

Today's Gospel: Mark 16:15-20

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. It's been about 40 days since Jesus rose from the dead on Easter. During that time, Jesus appeared to many people, especially the Apostles. He showed them again and again that He is the Son of God.

Today it's time for Jesus to go back to heaven. But Jesus' Ascension isn't the end of the story. In the gospel, Jesus tells the people one last thing. "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." He taught the Apostles and other disciples all about God while He was here on Earth. Now Jesus wants the Apostles to continue sharing the Good News of God. He wants them to go out into the whole world. He wants them to proclaim the gospel to everyone. The teachings of Jesus are for everyone in the whole world.






