## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we begin the merry month of May, a busy and beautiful month in the life of our parish and school. May is the month especially dedicated to the honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Let us honor her with our prayers and ask her for her intercession and motherly protection for all of us. Let us ask her to "pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death." Let us bring blossoms and blooms from the flowering lilacs to place before her image or as a crown upon her head.

Thank you for your response thus far to the Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Parassala, India. I have been thinking about the difficulties Bishop Eusebius must be facing due to the great surge in COVID-19 cases in India overwhelming the health care system and resulting in many deaths from the virus. If you would still like to donate to Bishop Eusebius and the Diocese of Parassala, please do so using the baskets in church marked "Missionary Collection," or by using the EFT option, or simply send your donation to the parish office.

May is also the month when we launch the Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA). Last year, we didn't do that in May due to the shutdown, so this year as we begin the 2021 BAA on the first weekend in May, it is a very welcome sign to us that we are beginning to return to "normal." Let's hope that we continue to get back to normal, little by little, step by step. The Bishop's Annual Appeal is our way of supporting the important works of the Diocese of Columbus which help our parishes continue their ministry, support our schools, prepare our future priests and deacons, and support charitable and pastoral programs. I have often said that the BAA is not just another "second collection," but it is more like the Diocese's regular Sunday collection--just as the parishes depend on the Sunday collection to carry out their work all year long, so the Diocese depends on the BAA to carry out its work all year long. So, I believe we should all support this appeal according to our means. The overall diocesan goal for this year's BAA is \$6.85 million. St. Andrew's Parish goal is \$211,393. I hope you will make a pledge or a generous one-time gift to this year's BAA. And no gift is too small. Each and every gift is greatly appreciated. You may place pledge envelopes in the regular offertory baskets anytime over the next several weeks or mail them to St. Andrew Parish or directly to the Diocese of Columbus. I thank you most sincerely for your consideration and support for the Bishop's Annual Appeal.

The “flagship” charity fundraiser for the State of Ohio Knights of Columbus is “Measure Up”. Measure Up is an annual campaign to raise money to assist individuals with developmental disabilities. This fundraising effort raises more than \$360,000 for over 322 statewide and local caring agencies that sponsor a variety of training and support programs.



Council 11275 annually participates in the Measure Up campaign. Due to the pandemic, last year’s campaign was held online. To minimize risk to both our members and the community, Council 11275 decided to forego the traditional street corner collection. Despite these changes, we raised almost \$2,400, thanks to the generosity of St. Andrew parishioners!

This year we are holding a hybrid campaign. If you missed our street corner collection on **Saturday, May 1 at “5 Points” intersection in UA**, you can donate either through our PayPal account or by check payable to “St. Andrew Council 11275.” The check can either be mailed to the parish or dropped in the collection basket at any of the weekend Masses. If using the collection basket, please print “K of C” on the outside of the envelope and “Measure Up” on the memo line of your check.

Of the money collected, 80 percent is returned to the individual councils for donating to their local agencies of choice. The remaining 20 percent is donated to specific statewide programs, such as Special Olympics. This year, 100% of the proceeds returned to St. Andrew through the online portion of the campaign will be donated to S.P.I.C.E. (Special People in Catholic Education)! S.P.I.C.E. addresses a variety of St. Andrew student needs.

## Children's Liturgy of the Word

### Today's Gospel: John 15:1-8


