St. Andrew Church is a community of Catholics committed to serving God by living our faith. We exist to fulfill the mission of the Roman Catholic Church at the local level by continuing the saving work of Christ. We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I have a lot of important information to share with you today. As you certainly already know, Governor DeWine has lifted all health orders effective June 2. Furthermore, the Bishops of Ohio have announced that the dispensation from the Sunday obligation, which has been in effect for more than a year, is coming to an end. As of the weekend of June 5/6 (the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ) all Catholics in Ohio are once again obligated to attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. The Sunday Obligation can only be fulfilled by "in-person" attendance at Mass, for which there is no substitute. All of us are grateful that we have had the opportunity to participate in Mass remotely by Livestream or broadcast Mass. These have kept us connected to our parish and enabled us to keep holy the Lord's Day during the times that we couldn't safely attend Mass in person. And St. Andrew Parish will continue to offer the Livestream Mass for the sake of those who are homebound, ill, or legitimately excused from attending Mass in person because of illness, caring for someone who is ill, or because they are higher risk for infection, or fearful. Such persons are excused from the Sunday obligation and do not need a formal dispensation. Those who are healthy and able are obligated to attend Mass on Sundays or the vigil, beginning June 5.

To prepare for the anticipated increase in Mass attendance, Bishop Brennan has encouraged parishes to make room in the church, particularly by opening up the pews. Here at St. Andrew, the ropes are coming down! We will no longer block off every other pew to enforce social distancing.

This does not mean that everything at Sunday Mass is returning to pre-pandemic normalcy. In keeping with the governor's order and recently revised guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), after June 2, fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks, outside or inside, nor do they need to socially distance from other fully vaccinated persons. Those who are not vaccinated (including children) should continue to mask when in church and to observe social distancing. Our Catholic leaders – Pope Francis, Bishop Brennan, and Yours Truly – strongly urge those who have not yet been vaccinated to do so. The COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective and are the best way to prevent this disease. And by becoming fully vaccinated, you will experience a great deal more freedom.

Although fully vaccinated people are not required to wear masks when coming to church after June 2, nevertheless, all are welcome and heartily encouraged to use masks. The priests, deacons and Communion ministers will still "mask up" when distributing Holy Communion. For the time being, we will continue to distribute Communion in the same manner as we have been doing for the past year, so continue to follow the arrows on the floor during the Communion procession. Similarly, we are not quite ready to restore the exchange of the Sign of Peace just yet, nor the filling of the Holy Water fonts. But it might not be too long before these are back. On the other hand, I believe it may be a long time before we are able to safely resume "Communion from the Cup."

Also, once school is out for the Summer, I plan to re-open the "Door 17" entrance to the lower level, the stairwell, elevator, and restrooms. The hand sanitizer stations will continue to be available and all are encouraged to use them frequently. As soon as is practical to do so, we will no longer prop open the doors of the church, and we will remove the signs and posters with the COVID protocol notices.

I want to thank all of you for your patience, cooperation, and obedient compliance with the safety protocols over the last year. Although the pandemic is not over, we have come a long way.

Whew! That was a lot of information. I hope I didn't forget anything. We have been waiting a long time for COVID restrictions to be loosened, and now it is finally beginning to happen. Let us give thanks to God, and especially let us gather together as the People of God in our beautiful Church of St. Andrew each and every Sunday from now on and offer Him the Sacrifice of Praise. On this Feast of Pentecost, may the Holy Spirit kindle in our hearts the fire of His love!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and I am Father Ferguson's cat! Well, I've been jumping on and off all the beds in the house because today is a really special day in the Church. Today is a special Solemnity called "Pentecost"! That's right!



Every year, we celebrate Pentecost on day number 50 after Easter. That's because the Bible tells us that on the 50th day after Easter (and 10 days after Jesus ascended into Heaven), Jesus sent His Holy Spirit down on the Apostles in a really powerful way.

You see, the Apostles were being like a bunch of scaredy-cats who hear dogs barking nearby. They ran and hid behind locked doors. They were still afraid that what happened to Jesus (think...the Cross!) would happen to them, because the leaders of the people were not being nice to those who wanted to follow Jesus.

So, Jesus wanted to give the Apostles courage to go out and tell the world about God's love and about Jesus opening up Heaven for everybody by His Resurrection. To do this, Jesus sent down His Holy Spirit into that locked room. And the Apostles received great courage to go out and share the Good News, no matter how much they might get picked on.

In fact, a lot of people out there do not yet know much about Jesus and are waiting for someone like you to tell them about Him. Do you have friends you know who don't know much about Jesus? Why not tell them about how amazing Jesus is! And don't be afraid or shy like some cats: it can be as simple as meowing to your friends about how much Jesus feels like a great friend to you. And when you do, you can know that the Holy Spirit of Jesus is working through you in a powerful way! Happy Pentecost! Have a "purr"-fect week!



Children's Liturgy of the Word

Today's Gospel: John 20:19-23

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen. Today is Pentecost. We celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit. At the Ascension, Jesus told the Apostles to go to Jerusalem and wait for a special gift that He would send to them. The Apostles didn't know what to think. They saw Jesus lift up into the sky and they were scared of what might happen next. A few days later, they would receive the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is the third part of the Trinity. It can also be hard to understand. There are no pictures of the Spirit, although sometimes it's represented by a flame or a dove or the color red. We receive the Spirit at Baptism and are sealed with the Spirit at Confirmation. But what does it mean to have the Holy Spirit with us?

The Holy Spirit is with us all the time. It can give us strength and peace when we're scared. We can ask the Spirit to help us make decisions. Have you ever had a really good or yucky feeling after you do something? That's the Spirit letting you know if you made a good choice. The Holy Spirit can also help us understand God's teachings better.

Take time today to thank God for the gifts of the Holy Spirit.




