In last week's bulletin, I took the occasion to explain in detail how the lifting of health orders and the reinstatement of the Sunday obligation will be implemented at St. Andrew Parish.

I hope that you welcomed this as good news, and a sign of returning to normal after a long, difficult, and confining year in which it was a challenge to fulfill our religious duties and to stay connected to our parish community.

This week, I want to take the opportunity to express my thanks to one and all for your steadfastness and loyal support throughout these trying times.

First of all, thank you for your obedient cooperation with all the safety protocols which have been in place throughout the pandemic, and which are happily being relaxed at the present time. St. Andrew parishioners have been very compliant and uncomplaining through all these months, and I know that isn't the case everywhere. Thank you for your cooperation and for doing what was asked for the sake of everyone's safety. I also want to thank you parishioners of St. Andrew for your continuous, dependable financial support for St. Andrew Parish all through these months. In spite of economic hardships, closed businesses, loss of income and/or employment, and other hardships brought on by the pandemic, St. Andrew parishioners still came through to support our parish. Even when there were very few people attending Mass, parishioners kept their donations and offerings coming, for which I am most grateful.

I want to thank our heroic teachers, staff, and administration of St. Andrew School for all of their sacrifices and efforts which enabled our St. Andrew School students to safely have in-classroom schooling all throughout the 2020-21 school year. This is truly a rare accomplishment!

I also want to thank the amazing staff of St. Andrew Parish for all of their efforts "above and beyond" to get us through this year with all of its unusual demands. Our Religious Education staff adapted to the situation and also planned and delivered meaningful and safe sacramental celebrations including First Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion. Our maintenance staff had to adapt to pandemic demands, like preparing new classroom spaces, constant cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces, and preparing the facilities for Christmas and Easter, all while keeping up with all of the routine maintenance. We installed a new livestream camera in the church last year, and this has been a Godsend for those who could not attend Mass in person. My thanks to those who faithfully operated the camera to make the Mass available to our parishioners and others in their homes. And thanks to the Catholic Foundation for the grant which made this possible. I am also thankful to the parish consultative bodies which continued to meet this past year (by ZOOM of course). The Liturgy Committee helped plan wisely and successfully for Christmas and Easter when we really didn't know what to expect. The Parish Council and the Finance Council provided invaluable guidance and have kept our parish on the right track.

To all parishioners, please accept my humble thanks for your generous, constant and dependable cooperation and support!

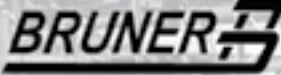

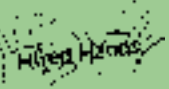
