

The remaining 20 percent is donated to specific statewide programs, such as Special Olympics. This year, 100% of the proceeds returned to St. Andrew through the online portion of the campaign will be donated to S.P.I.C.E. (Special People in Catholic Education)! S.P.I.C.E. addresses a variety of St. Andrew student needs.




