We exist to fulfill the mission of the Roman Catholic Church at the local level by continuing the saving work of Christ. We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend, we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, or The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This is also the weekend that the Sunday obligation is reinstated. For over a year, the obligation of attending Mass on Sunday, which normally binds all Catholics unless legitimately excused, was dispensed. Beginning on this feast of Corpus Christi, it is once again in force, and I for one am glad of it! I am sure there are many historical examples of times when Christians were prevented from freely gathering for the Eucharist because of persecution. But I am not aware of any precedent for such a broad and long-lasting dispensation from the Sunday obligation. This was a history-making event which we have personally experienced and survived. We should not forget what we have been through, but we should be glad that it is over. We should now joyfully and eagerly fulfill our Sunday obligation and join our fellow believers around the altar of God to partake of the Bread of Life. How appropriate that we resume obligatory Mass attendance on this feast, because our partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ is the very reason we come to Mass. If you have missed partaking of the Holy Eucharist, now is the time to be fed and refreshed once again.

As we return to regular Mass attendance for all and regular reception of Holy Communion, I want to remind you that the reception of Holy Communion under the form of bread only will continue to be the norm for the foreseeable future. I do not know when we may return to Communion from the cup. You are once again free to receive Communion in the hand or on the tongue. If you receive in the hand, please be sure to consume the host immediately after receiving it, in view of the priest or Communion minister. Do not carry the host away or back to the pew before consuming it.

In the coming weeks, we will be restoring the use of Holy Water. Please remember that using Holy Water is optional. We will also begin to exchange the sign of peace once again--but please note that physical contact (shaking hands or hugs) should be reserved for members of your family. For all others, a non-tactile expression is appropriate, such as a spoken greeting like "Peace be with you."

I am so happy to be seeing more and more parishioners at Mass each Sunday. I have truly missed seeing many of you and am happy to see you again after a long absence. Let us together thank the Lord and praise His name!
