MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR


Dear Parishioners,

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Like many animals, I like to stay up late at night. Some nights, I hunt unsuspecting prey, but other nights, especially in the summer, I like to lie on the ground and look up and behold all the stars in the sky. Have you ever done that? There are so many stars in the whole Universe...more than you can count! I mean, billions and trillions of them! And the universe is so big, that even as fast as light can travel (186,000 miles per second, to be exact!), some stars are so far away from us that it takes their starlight billions of years to get to us! That's a long way away! Isn't it amazing how big a Universe God was able to create?
