

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is one of my favorite Holy Days of the year, as it falls right in the middle of August. This feast always brings back many happy memories of summers of my childhood. Today I was thinking about how we prayed before our meals in my family. After we said the usual prayer "Bless us, O Lord, and these, thy gifts..." we always ended with the acclamation "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee." I asked my mother once why we added this, as I noticed that others outside of our family did not include this phrase when they prayed before meals. She told me that in the Holy Year of 1950, the Pope suggested that this phrase be added in observance of the Holy Year and that our family began the practice then and simply continued it even after the Holy Year had ended.

I wasn't born until 1956, so I had no memory of the Holy Year of 1950 (although I had seen pictures of it as we had a collection of "View-Master" slides including some of Rome and the Vatican during the Holy Year of 1950). Also in 1950, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the mystery we celebrate on this feast. In the apostolic constitution "Munificentissimus Deus," Pope Pius XII declared that the Virgin Mary, "immaculate in her conception, a virgin inviolate in her divine motherhood, the wholehearted companion of the divine Redeemer who won complete victory over sin and its consequences, gained at last the supreme crown of her privileges – to be preserved immune from the corruption of the tomb, and, like her Son, when death had been conquered, to be carried up body and soul to the exalted glory of heaven."

To this day, when my siblings and I are together, 71 years after the Holy Year of 1950, we still end our meal-blessing with the prayer "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee."

Happy August and Happy Feast of the Assumption!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Did you know that today is a really special day for us in church? That's right, today is a type of celebration called a "Solemnity," and it's the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Wow! That's a mouthful! (I may have to swallow all my tuna the next time I try to meow that!)

What is this special day all about? You may already know that St. Mary is the mother of Jesus. One of the ways we refer to her is "Blessed Virgin Mary." St. Mary had a lot of important moments in her life, like when she was visited by the angel Gabriel, who told her that she was soon going to become the mother of Jesus (that's the "Annunciation"); or, when she actually gave birth to Jesus (that's "Christmas"); or, when she was with Jesus at His first miracle to tell Him to change the water into wine (that was the "Wedding at Cana")... (Mmm...I wonder if she could get Jesus to change water into milk...yum!); or, when she stood at the foot of the Cross to accompany Jesus as He gave Himself up for us to defeat evil and open up Heaven for us (that was part of the "Passion of Christ").

After the Resurrection, Jesus went up to Heaven (that's called the "Ascension"), and then St. Mary helped the Apostles to pray and to spread the faith. Some think that St. Mary lived in the same house as St. John in

the city of Ephesus as she got older. But at the end of her life here on Earth, St. Mary experienced a special miracle: she didn't die the same way that all other humans do, but she was "assumed" up into Heaven, body and soul. That's right! We call that miracle the "Assumption"! That's because St. Mary was always without sin.

St. Mary already has her glorified body in Heaven. For the rest of us, our bodies have to be buried in the ground after we die, and God will give us new bodies at the end of time. One of the ways we know that St. Mary really experienced the "Assumption" is because the early Christians would keep the bodies of the saints in special places to show them respect and to pray with them (because the bodies of the saints are sacred and holy...we call them "relics"). But did you know that no early Christian church ever claimed to have "relics" of the body of Mary? It would be impossible, because Mary was brought up into Heaven, entirely body and soul, at her "Assumption!"

What a special person St. Mary is! She's not only the mother of Jesus, but she wants to love YOU as a mother, as well! She's there to encourage you to stay holy so you can enter Heaven, too. Why not take a few minutes today, on this Solemnity of the Assumption, to pray to Mary our Mother, and ask her to send you lots of love and encouragement?

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Feast Day: August 15

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church.

Scripture does not give an account of Mary's assumption into heaven. Nevertheless, Revelation 12 speaks of a woman who is caught up in the battle between good and evil. Many see this woman as God's people. Since Mary best embodies the people of both Old and New Testaments, her assumption can be seen as an exemplification of the woman's victory.

Since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus' life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary's share in His glorification. So close was she to Jesus on earth, she must be with Him body and soul in heaven.

In the light of the Assumption of Mary, it is easy to pray her Magnificat (Luke 1:46–55) with new meaning. In her glory she proclaims the greatness of the Lord and finds joy in God her savior. God has done marvels to her and she leads others to recognize God's holiness. She is the lowly handmaid who deeply reverenced her God and has been raised to the heights. From her position of strength she will help the lowly and the poor find justice on earth, and she will challenge the rich and powerful to distrust wealth and power as a source of happiness.
