Dear Parishioners:

This is an exciting week at St. Andrew Parish because school starts this Wednesday! St. Andrew School is preparing to welcome all of our students as they begin a year of learning, growth, and formation in the Faith. These children will grow physically, academically, spiritually, morally, and every other way, thanks to our great teachers and staff and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. I offer my prayers for the health, safety, happiness, and success of all of our students throughout this school year, and I ask God's richest blessings upon them and their teachers that the lamp of knowledge and wisdom may light their way throughout this school year. And I also offer my prayers and ask God's blessing upon all of the parents of school-age children. I knew that my parents had both graduated from Catholic schools, my mother from St. Cecilia in Cincinnati, and my father from Holy Angels in Sidney, but I did not have that option. I attended weekly after-school Catechism classes throughout my school years, and my parents and other family members taught me the faith by word and example. But I still wished I could go to a Catholic school! Even though there may be some inconveniences this school year with temporary mask requirements and other safety practices, these are far outweighed by the great opportunity and privilege of attending a Catholic school and being educated and formed in the Faith!

To all students, staff, parents, and families, Let's have a great year! And to all of you, let's never stop learning, let us grow ever more in the knowledge and love of God.

I went to my calendar today to pencil in my schedule of naps for this coming week. But when I checked my calendar today, I noticed something: School starts up again this week! Summer vacation is over! COMING IN SEPTEMBER: FALL PARISH CONSULTATION SESSIONS

As part of the ongoing strategic process for *Real Presence, Real Future*, the Diocese of Columbus will be hosting Consultation Sessions for each parish throughout the Fall. Two Sessions will be held via Zoom videoconferencing for each parish in the Diocese. Facilitators will guide parishioners through important statistical and sacramental information relevant to the Diocese as a whole, to parishes in surrounding areas, as well as individual parish information. Parishioner participation in these sessions is critical to helping shape the future of the Diocese of Columbus.

The Parish Consultation Sessions are a vital part of the planning process that encourages parishioners to offer insights and perspective on the future planning of their parish. The feedback provided during these sessions will be used to draft new models for review by parishioners in early 2022. The consultation process will continue throughout 2022 until final models are approved. No decisions have been made regarding any parish, and none will be made until feedback is gathered directly from parishioners through the consultation process.

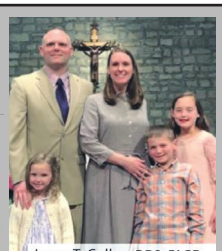
