MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This week marks the end of August, which means that Summer, for practical purposes, is over. As hot as the weather has been lately, I am ready for more refreshing Fall temperatures. But I have observed over the last ten years or so that September weather is often uncomfortably warm and sticky. When I observe all the extreme weather events causing death, destruction, and damage around the country, I realize I should not complain about heat and humidity. Thanks be to God, we have not experienced major flooding, hurricane winds, or wildfires here. Nor have we experienced destructive earthquakes, as has Haiti. Haiti suffered a major earthquake a few weeks ago, causing much damage and loss of life. The population of Haiti is very poor, to begin with, and the government there is not functioning. As a result, they are in desperate need of relief. The National Conference of Catholic Bishops and our own Bishop Brennan has called upon Catholics to help, and have asked parishes to conduct a voluntary special collection for relief for Haiti. Here at St. Andrew Parish, we will take up this collection on the weekend of September 4 and 5. I hope you will be generous to this relief effort.

On another matter, I want to call your attention to the upcoming Parish Consultation Sessions for the "Real Presence, Real Future" strategic planning process underway in our diocese. There are two opportunities for St. Andrew parishioners to participate in a video conference session via Zoom on either Monday, Sept. 27, or Wednesday, Sept. 29. These sessions are specifically for St. Andrew Parish and are your opportunity to have input into the planning process which will affect the future of our parish. Watch for information about registering for these sessions which will be coming soon. I hope you will participate in the important planning process.

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! I just completed my first couple of days of Kitty School! Have you started school this past week? How did it go?



I have to admit, I had a rough go the first few days. It has been difficult to get used to following all the rules again that my teachers and my Principal have at school. The Parish Consultation Sessions are a vital part of the planning process that encourages parishioners to offer insights and perspective on the future planning of their parish. The feedback provided during these sessions will be used to draft new models for review by parishioners in early 2022. The consultation process will continue throughout 2022 until final models are approved. No decisions have been made regarding any parish, and none will be made until feedback is gathered directly from parishioners through the consultation process.
