MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Just when things were more or less getting back to “normal,” the Delta variant of the Coronavirus has reared its ugly head! Not too many weeks ago, the CDC (Centers for Disease Control) recommended that those who are fully vaccinated need no longer wear masks indoors or outside. What a breath of fresh air (literally!) that was! It gave many of us a sense of freedom and made us think that the pandemic was almost past.

Now, the advice of the CDC and other health agencies and departments has been modified in light of the spread of the Delta variant. Because this variant is more highly contagious and may infect even fully vaccinated individuals who can become carriers and spreaders of the virus (even though they may not experience symptoms or severe illness themselves), it is now recommended that all people, both those unvaccinated and those fully vaccinated, should wear a mask indoors where people are gathered together in those areas where there is a substantial or high rate of transmission. This made me wonder if it was necessary to reinstate a mask requirement for those attending Mass or other events at St. Andrew Church – something that I am very reluctant to do. Of course, there are discussions taking place about the policy for schools and businesses, and workplaces. But what about church?

In recent weeks, our pews have been pretty full on Sundays. Very few people are wearing masks. We no longer block off pews to achieve social distancing and we have stopped the practice of vigorously sanitizing all surfaces before and after every Mass. We have retained the hand sanitizer stations and many still use them. The priests and other Communion ministers still wear masks when distributing Communion. But should we or should we not require that masks be worn at church?

Following a discussion of the Diocesan COVID-19 Task Force (of which I am a member), no recommendation or guidance is forthcoming to pastors at this time on this question and, as Gov. DeWine observed, there is currently “no appetite” for wearing masks! And, I have no appetite for enforcing mask-wearing! For the time being, therefore, speaking as Pastor of St. Andrew Parish, I am simply recommending that all of us pay careful attention to current guidelines and recommendations from the CDC and local health departments and heed those recommendations. I urge that the unvaccinated in particular heed the recommendation to be vaccinated.

Although I am fully vaccinated, I plan to resume wearing a mask in public indoor settings out of concern for my neighbors lest I unknowingly spread the Delta variant to them, and also to protect myself from a possible “breakthrough” infection. But until and unless I am instructed otherwise by a higher authority, I do not intend to require or enforce mask-wearing at St. Andrew Church. For now, this will be everyone’s personal responsibility. Of course, St. Andrew Church and St. Andrew School will always comply with all legitimate orders, policies, or mandates from the State of Ohio, the Diocese of Columbus, and other jurisdictions to which we are subject. As this is an evolving situation, please remain alert for any changes or updates to these recommendations.

Please stay safe, and may God bless and protect you all.

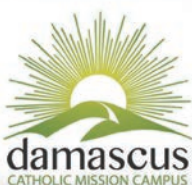
