

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend marks a somber and important anniversary – Saturday, Sept. 11, marks the 20th anniversary of the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and United Flight 93. How well I remember that day and the shock and dismay I felt as I watched the live news coverage of these horrible events, and especially seeing the towers of the WTC collapse. I am sure that, if you remember that day, you know what I am talking about. We saw unbelievable things that made us wonder if the end of the world was at hand. Of the many sad memories of that day, I also remember how churches filled with people on the evening of Sept. 11, 2001, as dazed and confused people turned to God in prayer. I was stationed in residence at St. Matthew Parish in Gahanna at the time, and I clearly remember how hundreds of people spontaneously came to the church that evening looking for some way to express their fear and doubt and recover some sense of hope and courage. Of course, nobody had any answers, and all we could do was to pray.

Now, 20 years later, we must not forget the lessons of that awful day. On this solemn anniversary, let us turn to God in prayer. Let us commend to Him all those who died as a result of these attacks, those who survived but continue to suffer in any way, those who lost loved ones, and the heroic first responders. Let us pray also that no such disastrous attack may ever again be visited upon the earth, and that our powerful God may protect us from all those who would do us harm.

On another matter, I bring to your attention again the opportunity to participate in the Parish Consultation Sessions for St. Andrew parishioners, which is part of the *Real Presence, Real Future* planning process taking place in our diocese. Specifically, your input is needed as the diocese plans for the future. Changes are inevitable in the future, and even a strong, thriving parish like St. Andrew will see changes. No plans have been decided upon yet, but possibilities are being proposed. By participating in the consultation sessions, you can offer your ideas to guide and refine the plans that will be developed. Our sessions are on Monday, Sept. 27, and Wednesday, Sept. 29 (choose one, not both). You must register for this virtual consultation session on the RPRF website: www.realpresencerealfuture.org.

COMING IN SEPTEMBER: FALL PARISH CONSULTATION SESSIONS

As part of the ongoing strategic process for *Real Presence, Real Future*, the Diocese of Columbus will be hosting Consultation Sessions for each parish throughout the Fall. Two Sessions will be held via Zoom video-conferencing for each parish in the Diocese. Facilitators will guide parishioners through important statistical and sacramental information relevant to the Diocese as a whole, to parishes in surrounding areas, as well as individual parish information. Parishioner participation in these sessions is critical to helping shape the future of the Diocese of Columbus.

The Parish Consultation Sessions are a vital part of the planning process that encourages parishioners to offer insights and perspective on the future planning of their parish. The feedback provided during these sessions will be used to draft new models for review by parishioners in early 2022. The consultation process will continue throughout 2022 until final models are approved. No decisions have been made regarding any parish, and none will be made until feedback is gathered directly from parishioners through the consultation process.

4. Meeting Jesus on His way to Calvary
5. Standing at the foot of the Cross: “Near the cross of Jesus there stood His mother.” (John 19:25)
6. Jesus being taken from the Cross
7. At the burial of Christ
