MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Autumn is here as of September 22, and the month of September hastens to its end. I would like to bring the following items to your attention as we prepare for the arrival of October.

This week our Parish Consultation Sessions for the *Real Presence, Real Future* planning process will be taking place on Monday, Sept. 27, and Wednesday, Sept. 29, 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. As I have already shared with you, these meetings are virtual and require preregistration. I hope that many of you will participate.

The weekend of October 2 and 3 will be a busy one here at St. Andrew Parish. Fr. Frank Brown, parochial vicar at St. Brendan Parish, will be present and speak at all Masses here at St. Andrew to invite young men and women who may be discerning a religious vocation to participate in the Melchisedek Project (for young men discerning priesthood) or Avow (for young women discerning religious life). You will remember Fr. Brown as our seminarian deacon who was with us here at St. Andrew's until the big shutdown in March 2020 ended it! I know he is looking forward to seeing St. Andrew parishioners once again.

On Sunday, Oct. 3, I will hold the annual Blessing of Animals or "Pet Blessing" in honor of St. Francis of Assisi at 1:30 p.m., on the Rectory front lawn. Please note the time as it is a bit earlier in the afternoon than we have done this in the past. Mabel and I look forward to welcoming all pets and their people for this special blessing.

Finally, I want to remind parishioners that St. Andrew Church is equipped with a "hearing loop" in our church. This is a radio-like system that turns your hearing aid into a receiver that plays the sound from the church's sound system right into your ear. However, your hearing aid must be equipped with a "T-coil." The Hearing Loop enables you to hear every word the lectors, deacons and priests say from the altar, pulpit and sanctuary. If you are having difficulty hearing the Mass, please check with your hearing aid provider and ask for a T-coil.

May God bless you all in this Autumn season!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Well, I hope your school year has been going well so far! It's fun to learn, isn't it? And you're never too old to learn, either. Did you know that Father Ferguson is also taking classes, too? That's right! He says it's about a special subject called the "Theology of the Body." That's a mouthful. But he says it's all about how God made our bodies to be something really special. Father says that one of our recent saints, Saint John Paul the Second (he used to be the "Pope," our leader as Catholics back when your parents were growing up), had a lot of wisdom to share about how special people's bodies are. Saint John Paul based his thinking on what we read in the Bible and on what Jesus tells us.

Father has been sharing some of what he is learning about this subject at my Kitty School (he knows "Meow" language), and I thought that I would, in turn, share some of what he says with all of you from time to time here in my columns.

The first lesson Father taught us is that you humans are special creatures (called "Persons") made by God with two very important "parts." Can you guess

what two parts make up every Person? They are your Soul, and your Body! That's right, you have to have both a Body and a Soul in order to be a full human person! And that kind of makes sense. After all, if you are a soul without a body, you are a special creature that we call an "angel." And if you are a body without a soul, you are...well...unfortunately, dead! (That's why Jesus resurrected: to overcome death, so that in Heaven, our body could once again have its soul.) So, as humans, you are meant to be a unity of Body and Soul!

That means that your body is pretty special. Your soul can tell your body what to do. What kinds of things do you make your body do each day? Get out of bed? Open your mouth to eat cereal? Get your legs to run to the school bus to catch it in time? Do exercises in gym class? Kiss your parents each night before bed? As a cat, I like to make my body stretch, jump to amazing heights, gobble up tuna, and pounce on unsuspecting prey. Isn't it amazing what you can do as a Person because you are a unity of a Soul with a Body?

Why not take a few moments today and thank God for creating you as a whole Person with both a Soul AND a Body? Have a "purr"-fect week!


