MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend is a holiday weekend, and Monday is Labor Day. On Wednesday, Aug. 18, I shared some thoughts at weekday Mass, when the gospel reading was the Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard. At the time, I thought that my reflections would be more meaningful on Labor Day, so I will share these thoughts with you today.

First of all, recall the parable, as found in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 20, verses 1-16: The owner of the vineyard hires workers at various times throughout the day – at dawn, mid-morning, noon, three o'clock and five o'clock. When they receive their pay, all the workers receive a full day's pay, even those who worked only an hour. I began my reflection by quoting one of my favorite prayers from the Liturgy of the Hours. It is taken from Daytime Prayer on Monday, which would normally be prayed in the middle of the workday, during a break or time of rest. The prayer uses the imagery of Jesus' parable, and portrays God the Father as the benevolent Owner of the Vineyard.

The prayer goes like this: *"Father, yours is the harvest and yours is the vineyard: you assign the task and pay a wage that is just. Help us to meet this day's responsibilities and let nothing separate us from your love. Grant this through Christ our Lord."*

I like this prayer because it reminds me that the work I do each day is God's work – He assigns the task. I invited the people to see their own daily work, whatever it may be, as God's work. Somehow, our work is elevated and has more meaning and purpose if we recognize that this is the work God has given us to do. When we pray this prayer in the middle of our workday, then we also are reminded that it is God who strengthens us to carry out our work and "meet our responsibilities." Apart from Him, we can do nothing, but if God is with us, all things are possible! And we have confidence that God will reward our labors, because He promises to "pay a wage that is just." God our Father, like the owner of the vineyard in the parable, gives us even more than we deserve or have earned, because He gives us eternal rewards for our short day's work in our brief life in this passing world.

I hope you find these thoughts meaningful as you celebrate Labor Day.

COMING IN SEPTEMBER: FALL PARISH CONSULTATION SESSIONS

As part of the ongoing strategic process for *Real Presence, Real Future*, the Diocese of Columbus will be hosting Consultation Sessions for each parish throughout the Fall. Two Sessions will be held via Zoom video-conferencing for each parish in the Diocese. Facilitators will guide parishioners through important statistical and sacramental information relevant to the Diocese as a whole, to parishes in surrounding areas, as well as individual parish information. Parishioner participation in these sessions is critical to helping shape the future of the Diocese of Columbus.

The Parish Consultation Sessions are a vital part of the planning process that encourages parishioners to offer insights and perspective on the future planning of their parish. The feedback provided during these sessions will be used to draft new models for review by parishioners in early 2022. The consultation process will continue throughout 2022 until final models are approved. No decisions have been made regarding any parish, and none will be made until feedback is gathered directly from parishioners through the consultation process.




