

We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Thanks to those of you who participated in the Parish Consultation Sessions for the "Real Presence, Real Future" diocesan planning process. We had a total of 66 participants in these sessions over the two evening meetings. Participants were given information about the viability of the parishes in our planning group, and were presented with some preliminary "models" for alliances or groupings of parishes that may need to take place in the future. Those who participated were also invited to submit input and reactions to the proposed models, and to suggest other possibilities to be considered.

It was also explained that in the not-too-distant future, there will be only 60 priests available to be pastors in the Diocese of Columbus. This means that all areas of the diocese will be facing a reduced number of priests to serve the parishes. Our planning area consists of five parishes: St. Andrew, St. Timothy, St. Christopher, St. Agatha and Our Lady of Victory. As of 2019, there were 7 priests assigned to serve these five parishes. The models presented call for only 4 priests to serve these same five parishes. As I have said before, changes in the future are inevitable and St. Andrew Parish will also be affected. That is why it is so important that we plan carefully. Again, my sincere thanks to those who participated.

Some may wonder whether the transfer of Bishop Brennan to lead the Diocese of Brooklyn will cause this planning process to stall or slow down. On Wednesday, Oct. 6, Bishop Brennan met with the priests of the diocese to discuss this very question. The priests are already convinced of the importance of the RPRF process, and the Bishop strongly encouraged us to keep the process moving forward, and not let his departure cause us to lose momentum. He assured us that he believed the next bishop, whoever that may be, will be grateful that the hard work of planning is already done, or well on its way to completion.

As I mentioned last week, Bishop Brennan will be installed in Brooklyn on November 30 (the Feast of St. Andrew). Until then, he is the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Columbus. After that, the diocese will be "Vacant" until the new bishop is installed. Nobody knows when that will be, but I suspect that I will see an increase in workload at the Diocese during that period, so I hope you will be understanding.
