

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR


Dear Parishioners:

I'm afraid I have some bad news for you. The air conditioning in church is broken and cannot be repaired. You probably suspected something was wrong if you attended Mass here last weekend and found the church doors wide open, fans running, and yourself sweltering! You may have also noticed several other times in the last several months when the AC was not functioning. Each time we had expensive repairs done so that it worked well enough to cool the church for a while, but it was only a "band-aid" solution. We were advised that the system needs to be replaced. This most recent failure is the final straw. The "chiller" is now kaputt! We will be replacing the chiller, but that isn't something that can happen overnight. A new chiller will not be installed until probably Spring of 2022. Until then, there will be no air conditioning in the church or parish hall. So pray for cool weather! By the way, a new chiller has a price tag of around \$140,000. I am sure you all agree that this is a necessary expense!

May God bless you all, and keep you cool and comfortable.
