## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This coming Monday is the beginning of the month of November. November is dedicated to the remembrance of the Faithful Departed. It is a time of prayer for all of our beloved dead. The month begins with the Solemnity of All Saints, which honors the holy men and women of every time and place who have fought the good fight, have completed their struggle and have taken their place in the assembly of God's holy ones in heaven. Because All Saints Day falls on a Monday this year, the obligation to attend Mass on this Holy Day has been dispensed. However, we will still observe this solemnity at our 6:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Masses that day. The 8:30 a.m. Mass will include our students of St. Andrew School, and special guests will be the members of the third grade, dressed as their favorite saint.

The following day, Tuesday, Nov. 2, is All Souls Day, a day we offer the Mass and our prayers for those who have died, and especially the "poor souls," those who are undergoing the final purification and penance of Purgatory in anticipation of their entrance into the perfect happiness of Heaven. Another opportunity to remember and pray for our departed loved ones will occur on the afternoon of Sunday, Nov. 7, when there will be a Remembrance Service with Evening Prayer in the church at 3:00 p.m. All are invited to this service, especially those who have lost loved ones recently and are still grieving. This remembrance service should bring comfort and hope to all those who mourn.

Finally, we will be displaying the "Book of the Dead" in the church vestibule all through the month of November. You are encouraged to write the names of your deceased loved one in the pages of this book, and the St. Andrew community will pray for all of these souls "who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith."

Throughout this month of November, let us pray for the faithful departed: "Eternal Rest grant unto them O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them."

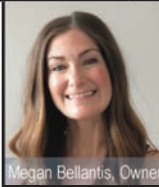
