

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

As we come to mid-November, it is hard to believe that Thanksgiving is only a week and a half away! The weather since the beginning of November has been mild, with most of the leaves still on the trees in beautiful shades of red, orange, russet and gold. So far, November has seemed more like mid-October. But Thanksgiving is just around the corner! I would like to offer a few thoughts today about the importance of being thankful.

I have observed that Thanksgiving is one holiday that is not "rushed," meaning it is not anticipated and prepared for weeks or months in advance. Many people decorate their front porches and yards for Halloween in September, and Christmas decorations go up even before Thanksgiving. I have observed homes where Christmas decorations go up alongside the jack-o'-lanterns, creating a somewhat "unharmonious" effect! But Thanksgiving seems to be confined to the day itself, that fourth Thursday in November. There is more anticipatory hype for "black Friday" than there is for Thanksgiving. But our giving thanks ought not to be confined to this one lonely holiday!

Not only should we begin the celebration early, weeks before the holiday, but truly we should dedicate each and every day of our lives to giving thanks to God. St. Paul tells us, "In all circumstances, give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Thess. 5:18). Do we not acclaim in every Mass that "it is truly right and just ALWAYS and EVERYWHERE" to give God thanks and praise? Every day of our lives, even in times of sorrow, sickness, or misfortune, we must give thanks to God, who is the author of life, the giver of every good gift. We have faced many different and difficult circumstances in our lives, and yet in all circumstances, whether good, bad, or indifferent, we must give thanks. So let's get a head start on the Thanksgiving holiday by giving thanks to God today and every day!

I will be away from St. Andrew Parish from November 22 through 27. I will be spending the week of Thanksgiving with my brothers and sisters. We are all gathering in our hometown of Ada and will be together for the holiday, for which I am very thankful!




