St. Andrew Church is a community of Catholics committed to serving God by living our faith. We exist to fulfill the mission of the Roman Catholic Church at the local level by continuing the saving work of Christ. We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

We recently concluded the annual "October Count," in which we count the number of people attending weekend Mass for all the Sundays in October and then calculate the average weekly attendance. The results are shared with the Diocese, which gathers these statistics from all the parishes in the Diocese and can observe trends. This year, our average weekend Mass attendance is 872.

You may recall back in the Fall of 2019 (before COVID), I announced that our October count for that year was 1,466, which was a significant decline from the previous year, and continued a pattern of declining Mass attendance over several decades. At that time, I was seeing the need to reduce our Mass schedule. In March 2020, the Coronavirus pandemic set in, there was a shutdown, and the Bishops of Ohio dispensed Catholics from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for a number of months. We began "livestreaming" Sunday Mass so that those who were avoiding gatherings of people could still have some connection to the worshipping community, albeit a "virtual" connection. At present, the Sunday obligation is again in force. Our "in person" Mass attendance is still well below our pre-COVID attendance. I presume that some parishioners may still be fearful about attending Mass with a large gathering of people, especially if they are not vaccinated or are vulnerable because of a health condition. Or perhaps their health has declined and they are no longer physically able to attend Mass. I also wonder if the long period in which the Sunday obligation was dispensed, has caused some to be less intent on fulfilling this obligation now that it is back in force and binding. And perhaps some consider the livestreamed Mass a convenient and acceptable substitute for "in person" attendance. I believe other parishes across the Diocese are experiencing similar results in their October counts. I do hope and pray that those who have not yet resumed regular "in person" Mass attendance will do so in the coming weeks.

We miss you! I hope that you will let me know if you are finding obstacles that prevent you from attending, so these may be addressed if possible. Also, if you are unable to come to church because of health reasons or are homebound, you may request Holy Communion to be brought to you by a communion minister, or perhaps a pastoral visit from one of the priests.

May God bless you all, and I hope to see you in Church!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR **PARISH CHILDREN**

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Before Halloween and All Saints Day, I was meowing to you about special stuff called the "Theology of the Body!" Remember what that means? That's a big phrase which means, "Your Body is a special part of who you are, because you are a creation of God!"

I was telling you all about how special your Body is because it's part of who you are as a human person. The other part of "you" is your Soul. Your Body can express your Soul in so many great ways. Remember?

Well, boys and girls, this week I want to meow to you something even more amazing. If YOU are special as a Body-Soul person, that means that OTHER people are special, too! Think about your parents, your brothers and sisters, your friends, your teachers, and everyone else you know. How many of them have a Body and a Soul? Well, hopefully, they ALL do! 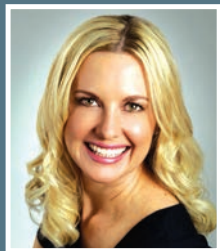

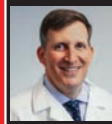
